## SJA Stewardship Report by Fr. Rich

Enclosed in this bulletin on page 5, you will find a report on parish/school revenues and expenditures from July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020. It seems appropriate to share this report on Thanksgiving Weekend because **I am so grateful to all of you, our parishioners and friends** who have so faithfully supported our parish community during one of the most difficult years we have ever experienced. Because of your continued generosity this year and in the past, our overall financial condition remains healthy in spite of the shortfall shown in the report. This shortfall is due to building projects (which we anticipated funding through our Capital Reserve Fund in lieu of a fundraising campaign), and an unanticipated drop in Sunday collections during the first half of the year due to the pandemic. Your generosity also allows us as a parish to reach out and assist many of our friends and neighbors who are struggling financially due to the pandemic.

I am also grateful to the members of our Finance Council, as well as to Theresa Segin, our Parish Business Manager, and Alyson Baranowski, our bookkeeper, who put together this report and who offer sound advice all year long.

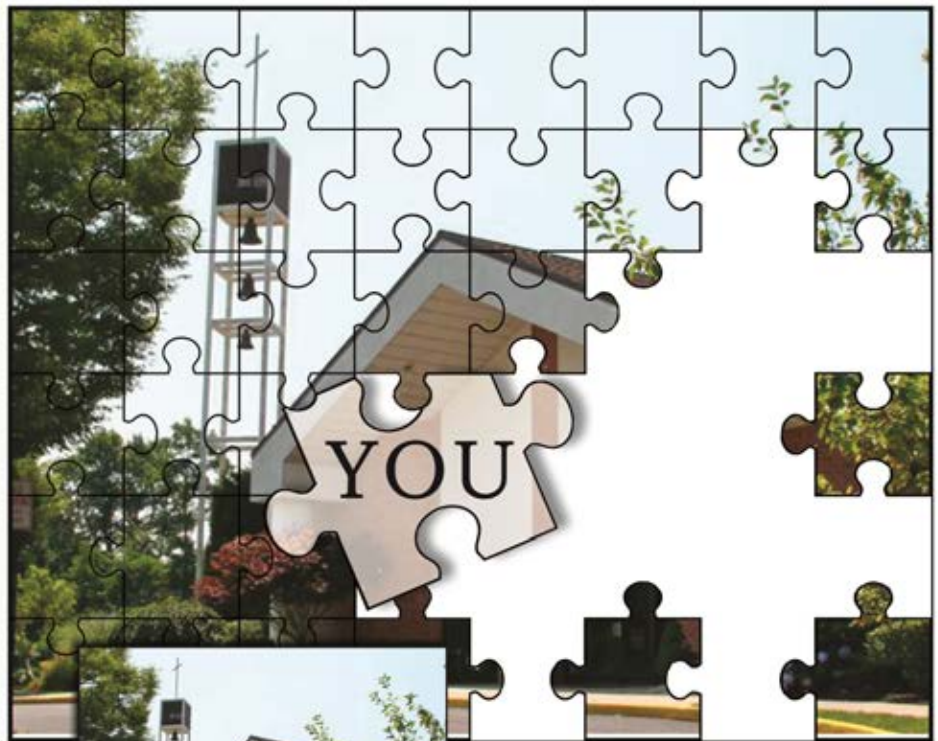

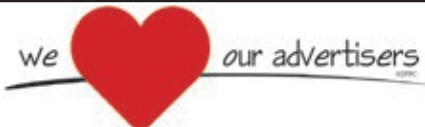
