Feast of the Holy Family

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

When we say that Jesus was “like us in all things but sin,” we mean it! To emphasize just how much Jesus was like us, God chose to have his Only-Begotten Son born and raised in a family.

Jesus knew *family life*. Let that sink in.

Think if Jesus had been born into *your* family. There’s a thought, huh? Let *that* sink in.

Everyone’s family is interesting (a gigantic understatement). What words would you use to describe your family and your extended family? And before you go and think the Holy Family had it easy, that every day was pumpkin pie and chocolate ice cream, consider these few points:

—Mary and Joseph were betrothed when she became pregnant ... not with his child. We have always called Joseph the foster father of Jesus.

—The baby Jesus’ first cradle was a manger ... that’s a trough that barn animals eat from.

—To protect his family and to escape violence, the Holy Family had to flee their homeland, becoming strangers in a foreign land.

—Once, when Jesus was 12 years old, his parents couldn’t find him. For *three* days.

—Mary had to watch her Son suffer torture and capital punishment, which for the Romans meant crucifixion.

So, the Holy Family knew difficulties and struggles and what we can even call desperate times. And yet even in the midst of this, they created an environment in which, as we are told in today’s Gospel, Jesus “grew and became strong, filled with wisdom” (Luke 2:40).

Jesus understands the difficulties and challenges of family life. Jesus also knows that it is in the context of family, that love and faith grow, that we learn patience and forgiveness, that we are challenged to be our best, to be good, to be holy.

It is Jesus that teaches us family goes beyond blood ties. He says those who listen to Him and do the will of God are “brother and sister and mother” to Him. Let’s let that sink in, too.

Advent at SJA Living in Hope

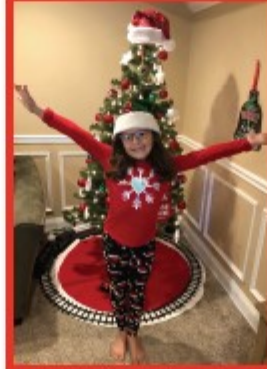
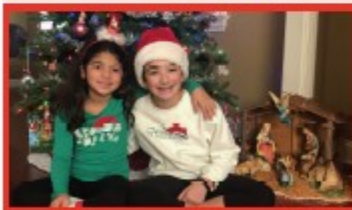
On December 7th COVID-19 caused us to go fully remote until January 4th. As usual, our students and parents have been amazing, and we are able to stay connected through technology.
