## GOSPEL MARK 1:1-8

The beginning of the gospel of Jesus Christ the Son of God.

As it is written in Isaiah the prophet:

*Behold, I am sending my messenger ahead of you; he will prepare your way.*

*A voice of one crying out in the desert:*

*“Prepare the way of the Lord, make straight his paths.”*

John the Baptist appeared in the desert proclaiming a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins. People of the whole Judean countryside and all the inhabitants of Jerusalem were going out to him and were being baptized by him in the Jordan River as they acknowledged their sins.

John was clothed in camel's hair, with a leather belt around his waist. He fed on locusts and wild honey.

And this is what he proclaimed:

“One mightier than I is coming after me. I am not worthy to stoop and loosen the thongs of his sandals. I have baptized you with water; he will baptize you with the Holy Spirit.”

- 3) St. John said: I am not worthy to stoop and loosen the thongs of his sandals. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit. How are you accepting that The Holy Spirit – one of the Trinity, lives within you?

I'll fit right into this Sunday's Gospel which is all about the Baptist preaching out in the wilderness. We don't have to go into a wilderness to do this. We can prepare the way of the Lord at home, at work, at school, even while shopping, cleaning, driving, standing in (a socially distanced) line, wherever we find ourselves and with whomever we happen to meet.

This week, let's do everything as if we are laying the foundation for the coming of the Lord Jesus.
