## A NORMAL DAY. REALLY?

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

How many times since last March have you wished for a bit of normalcy to return? And if not totally, completely normal, at least “next-to-normal” to quote the title of a Broadway musical some years back (remember when there were Broadway plays back when things were more normal?).

Probably not going to happen.

Maybe as Christians it is the last thing we should expect or even desire.

It was a normal day that Simon and his brother Andrew, and James and his brother, John, as well as their father, all went to work in their boats on the Sea of Galilee. The day started out, I’m sure, just like any other. The usual breakfast. The usual walk to the docks. Had to be early in the morning, so probably the usual lack of conversation; a few grunts here or there. The usual nets and boats. All normal.

And then everything changed. Jesus came by and invited them to follow him. No doubt they had heard word of this itinerant preacher. No doubt they never dreamed he’d have anything to do with them. No doubt they never imagined their “normal” lives would be turned upside-down.

But maybe that’s what Jesus does. He turns normal upside-down and inside-out, giving us a completely new way to see things, a completely new set of values, a new agenda, a new purpose, a new reason to live, to get up in the morning, to go to work, to make a living.

Every day is a new opportunity to encounter Jesus. To hear his voice. To look into his eyes. To hear him say, “Follow me.” To such an invitation, we might be inclined to reply, “You got the wrong gal or guy, Jesus. I just want to go about my normal life.” On the other hand, what if we drop our nets and computer mice and phones and followed Him. Imagine all that Jesus would show us. Imagine all that Jesus could do through us.

So, maybe instead of praying for normal, we should pray we won’t be afraid to meet Jesus and go where he leads, no matter how different, how out of the ordinary it feels. After all, that’s how Christianity, that’s how our Church, began.

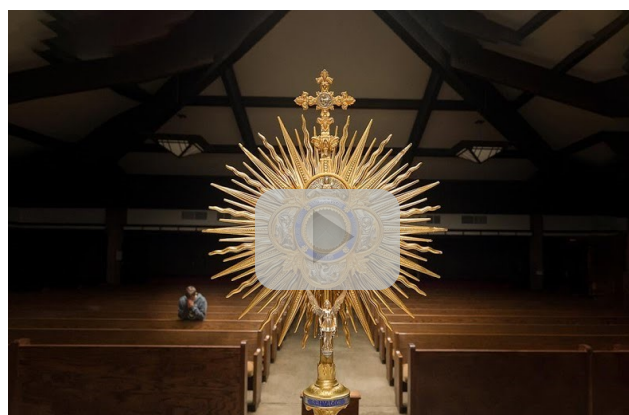

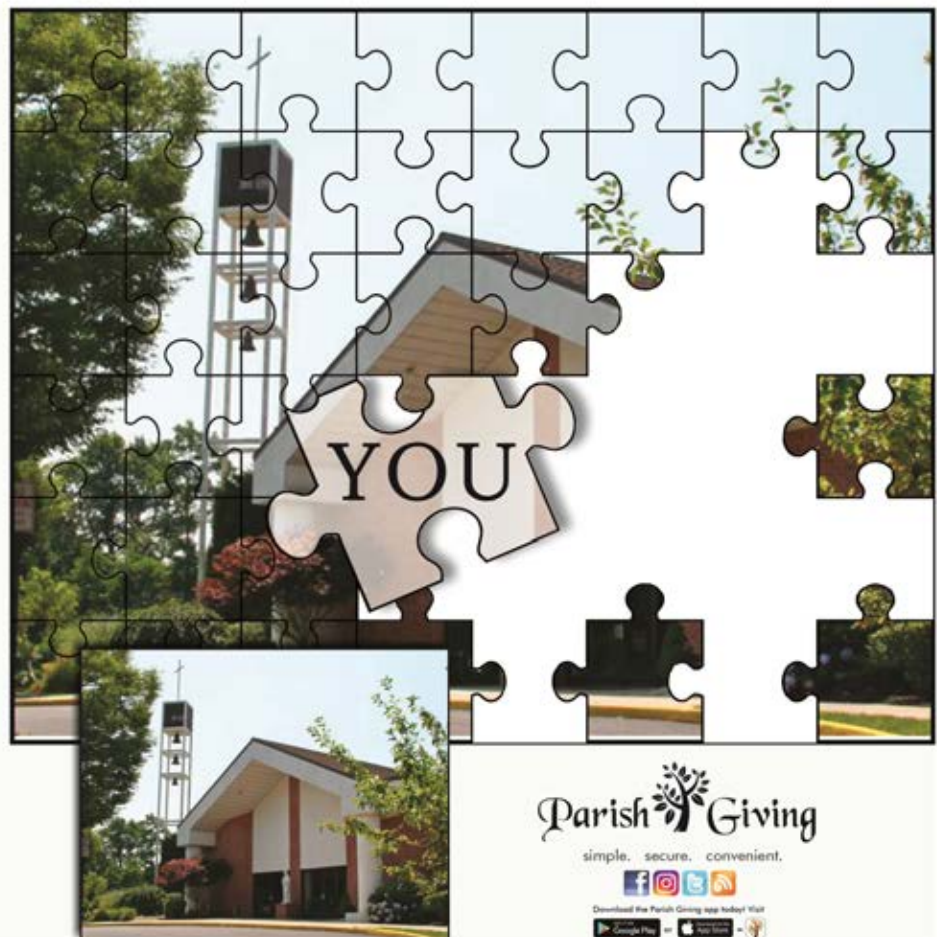

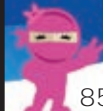
