UNCLEAN UP FRONT

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

In many ways, our Sunday gatherings are not all that different from the Sabbath experience we hear about in today's Gospel. Jesus and his newly minted disciples go into the synagogue in the seaside town of Capernaum. While there, they encounter a fellow who has an unclean spirit. Jesus faces the unclean spirit, the demon within, head on, silences it and casts it out. How, you might ask, is this like Sunday Mass?

Think about it: none of us walks through these church doors perfectly. (That goes for everyone worshipping at home, too!) We bring our "unclean spirits" to church, or at least we should! Yes, we should bring what ails us, our sinfulness, our inner disturbances and anxieties, the demons of every size and shape that can possess us. What better place to bring our prejudices and vendettas, our fears and worries, even our hypocrisies.

Yes, bring all that *gunk* to Mass. And let Jesus say to all our many unclean spirits, "Silence! Come out of them!" Because, yes, Jesus came to destroy them. Jesus, the Holy One of God, is far more powerful than the most powerful of demons in us and in the world.

There is a very good reason why the Church puts the Penitential Rite ("Lord, have mercy!") at the very beginning of Mass. Right up front we admit we are not perfect, we sin, we hurt ourselves and one another. Right up front we admit we mess up our lives, our relationships, our world. And, even more importantly, right up front we proclaim the power of God's great mercy!

Our Mass begins the same way the Gospel of Mark begins. Right up front, Mark shows us Jesus in action with a new kind of teaching, one with an authority, a power over everything destructive.

"Have you come to destroy us?" the unclean spirit asks Jesus. You betcha, Jesus says. To destroy precisely what destroys us and to heal us exactly where we hurt the most. That's what Jesus did back then in that synagogue and all throughout his ministry, culminating on the Cross. And that's what Jesus does for us now on every Sunday, in every Eucharist.

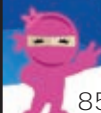
