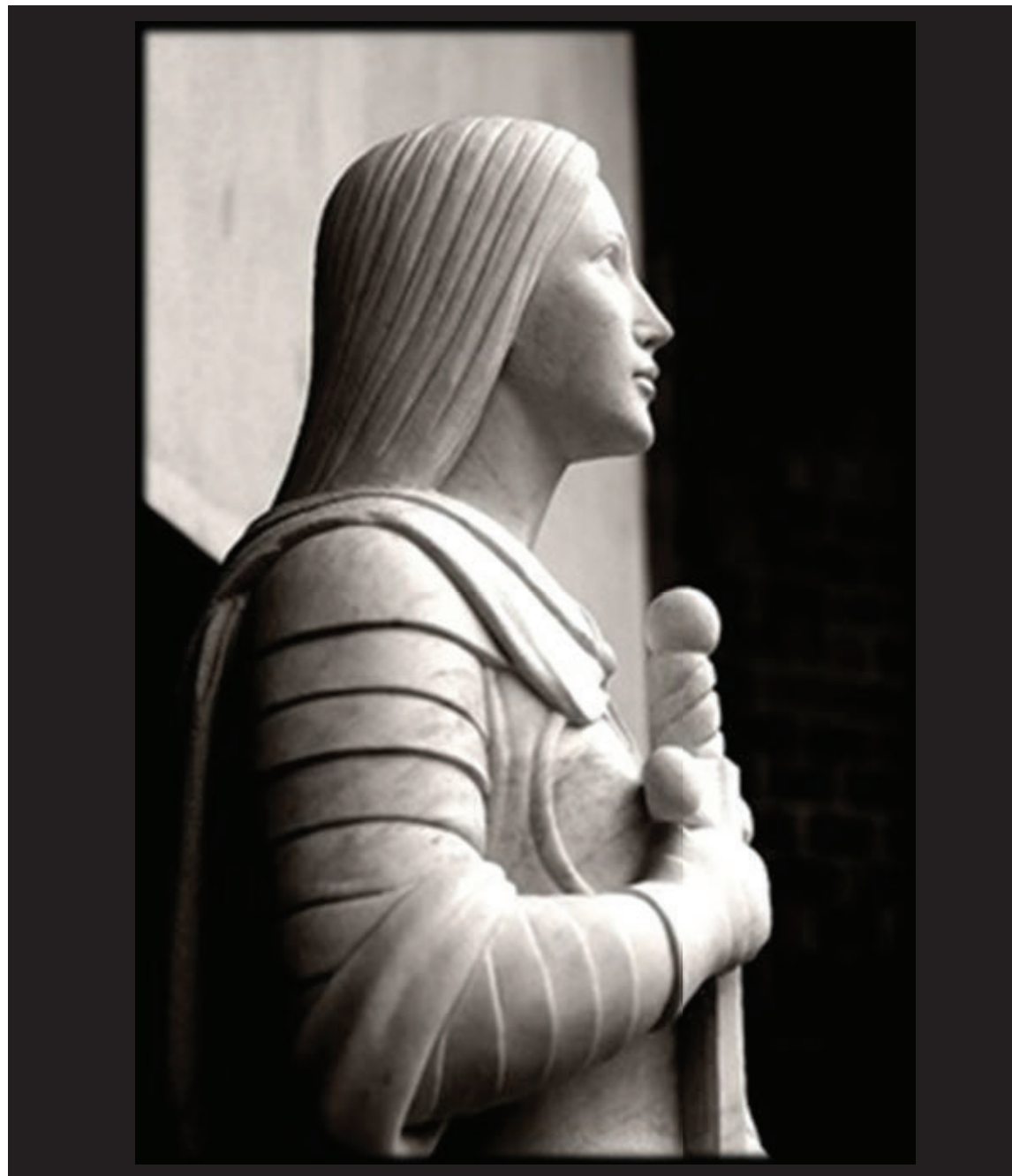

## GOSPEL JOHN 3:14-21

Jesus said to Nicodemus:

“Just as Moses lifted up the serpent in the desert, so must the Son of Man be lifted up, so that everyone who believes in him may have eternal life.”

For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him might not perish but might have eternal life. For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world might be saved through him. Whoever believes in him will not be condemned, but whoever does not believe has already been condemned, because he has not believed in the name of the only Son of God. And this is the verdict, that the light came into the world, but people preferred darkness to light, because their works were evil. For everyone who does wicked things hates the light and does not come toward the light, so that his works might not be exposed. But whoever lives the truth comes to the light, so that his works may be clearly seen as done in God.

## What We Mean When We Say We Believe

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

Christians do not believe in a set of abstract principles or truths. We do not believe in an ethical system. We do not believe in a philosophy or way of life. We do not believe in a nameless spiritual being or a cosmic force or energy.

We believe in Jesus Christ. Saying this means we believe God has a face, a voice, a heart. Saying this means we believe God is love. Saying this means we believe God has entered into a personal relationship with each of us and has put His Spirit within us.

Saying we believe in Jesus means we have a way to follow, a way to live. The truth we seek and follow is Jesus Himself; again, very personal and relational, not distant or aloof. To believe in Jesus is to believe we are all connected, united with God and with each other, with all, with everyone whom God loves.

Being in relationship with God means we have a history with God. It also means God is with us now. Furthermore, it means we have a future with God. It means we have never been alone, are not alone now, and will never be alone, not even in death.

Believing in Jesus means we believe God holds nothing back in His love for us, but gives us everything. Therefore, believing in Jesus opens us to the infinite. But, again, not some intangible infinite energy ... but the very real energy of love ... a love that knows our name.

Believing Jesus rose from the dead means we believe God's love is stronger than death.

When on Sunday, we say, “I believe in one God ... I believe in Jesus Christ ... I believe in the Holy Spirit ...,” this is what we mean: **“For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him might not perish but might have eternal life.”**

I could never say it better than that, believe you me.

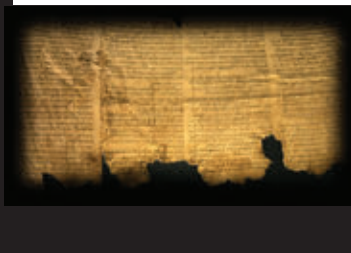

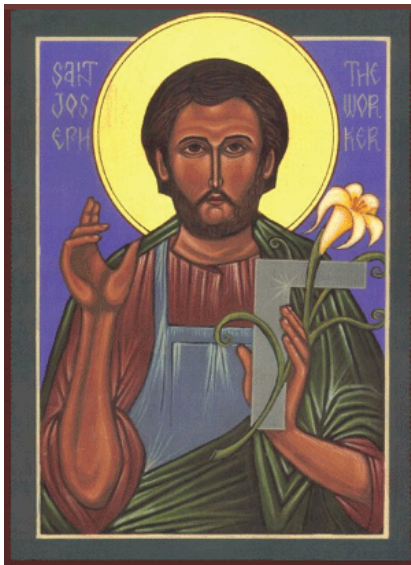
