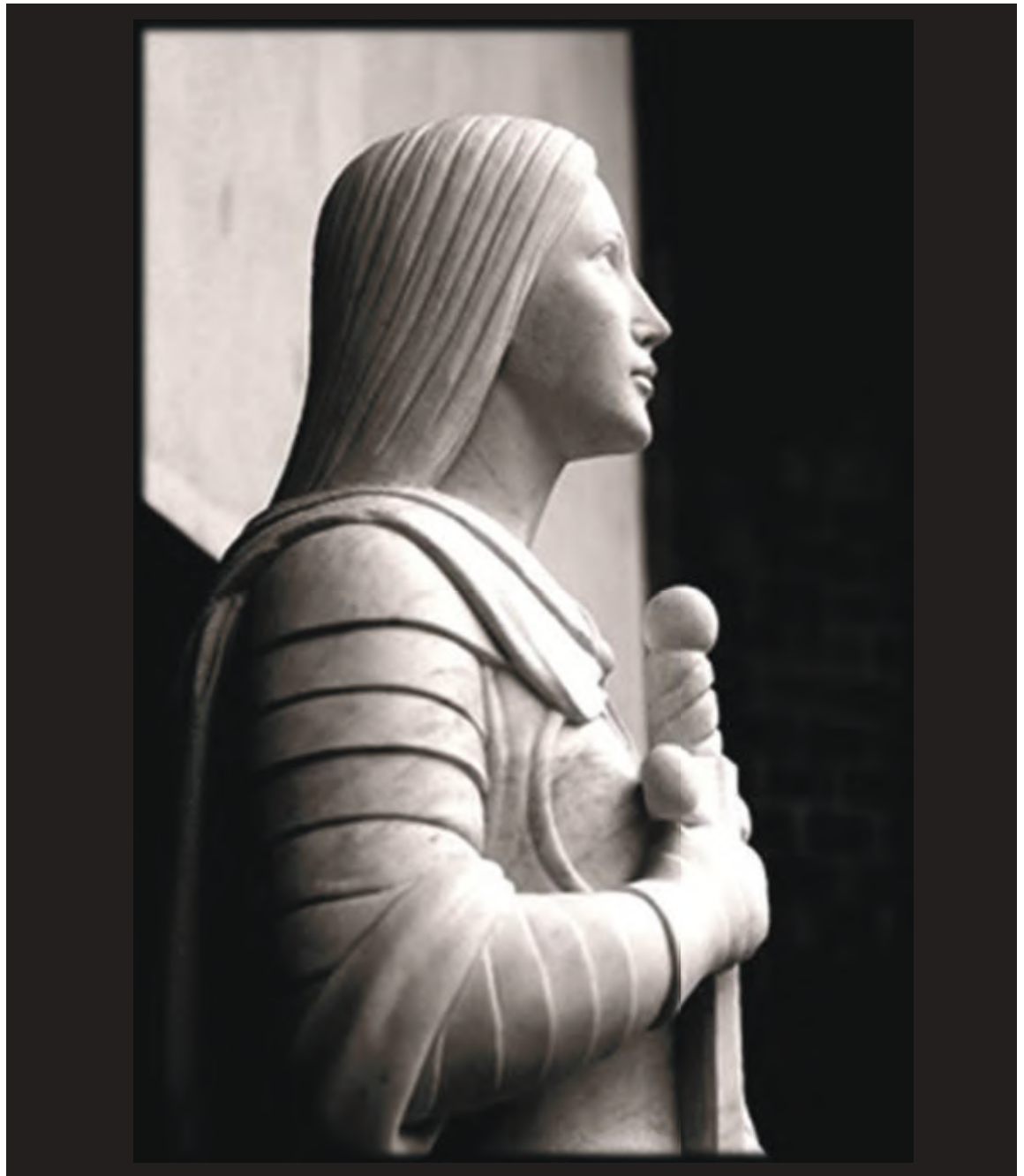

GOSPEL JOHN 2:13-25

Since the Passover of the Jews was near, Jesus went up to Jerusalem. He found in the temple area those who sold oxen, sheep, and doves, as well as the money changers seated there. He made a whip out of cords and drove them all out of the temple area, with the sheep and oxen, and spilled the coins of the money changers and overturned their tables, and to those who sold doves he said, "Take these out of here, and stop making my Father's house a marketplace." His disciples recalled the words of Scripture, *Zeal for your house will consume me*. At this the Jews answered and said to him, "What sign can you show us for doing this?" Jesus answered and said to them, "Destroy this temple and in three days I will raise it up." The Jews said, "This temple has been under construction for forty-six years, and you will raise it up in three days?" But he was speaking about the temple of his body. Therefore, when he was raised from the dead, his disciples remembered that he had said this, and they came to believe the Scripture and the word Jesus had spoken.

While he was in Jerusalem for the feast of Passover, many began to believe in his name when they saw the signs he was doing. But Jesus would not trust himself to them because he knew them all, and did not need anyone to testify about human nature.

He himself understood it well.

Money & Religion

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

Religion and money have had a very complicated relationship. We see it even in this Sunday's Gospel. Jesus is none too happy. He tells them they had turned the temple, the house of prayer into a marketplace.

The Church has often been accused of much the same. We know of that very sad part of our history when indulgences were sold. Even today many people say they no longer go to church because all they ever heard from the pulpit was money-talk. I well remember a Christmas homily I heard many years ago. The priest said he wanted a "silent collection," that is, no coins, only bills. Yikes! I was only a boy, long from even considering priesthood, and I cringed. I also remember, in a former parish of mine, a missionary came and gave the people what he called "the Jackson challenge." He said he didn't want any Washingtons or Lincolns; only Jacksons in the basket. I did more than cringe that time. I told the diocese to never welcome him back.

Talking about money has never been my favorite thing to do. Just writing the headline of this letter made me uneasy (you too, probably). As a pastor, of course, it is a necessity. I believe even Jesus, our chief Shepherd, knew that the walls of the very temple he was standing in, didn't get built without shekels.

The important thing, of course, whether inside the church or out in daily life, is not to get shackled to the shekels. As institutional Church, as local parish, and as individual disciples of Christ, our Savior's warning is only too clear: we cannot serve two masters.

I have found that, when speaking of dollars, the best thing to say is: **thank you**. And this gospel on this Sunday gives me an opportunity to say it again. I have been humbled by your generosity through the years but most especially during this pandemic. I know every cent you give to the Church of St. Joan of Arc is a sacrifice, a sacrifice you make with a great sense of commitment to your faith and a great love for God and this parish. I also know it comes from a compassionate heart that wants to help others who are in need. Please know how very grateful I am for all that you give and do for the Kingdom of God.

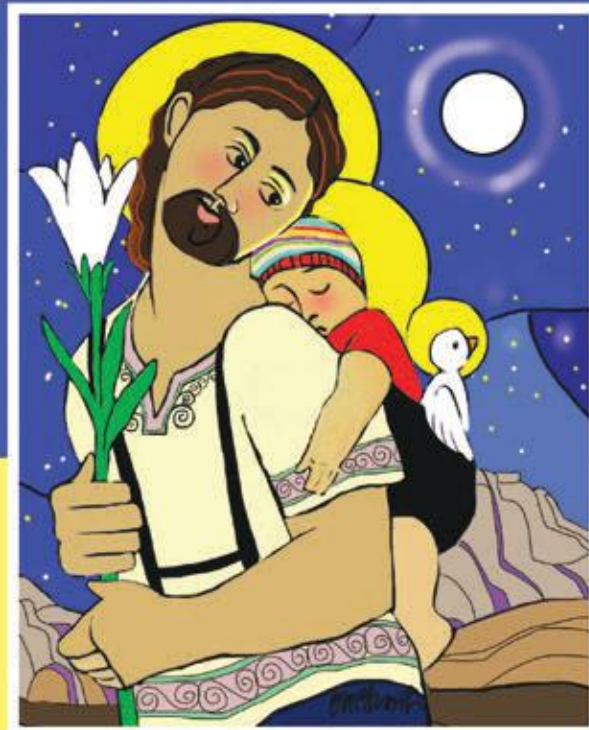
