GOSPEL JOHN 20:19-31

On the evening of that first day of the week, when the doors were locked, where the disciples were, for fear of the Jews, Jesus came and stood in their midst and said to them, "Peace be with you." When he had said this, he showed them his hands and his side. The disciples rejoiced when they saw the Lord. Jesus said to them again, "Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, so I send you." And when he had said this, he breathed on them and said to them, "Receive the Holy Spirit. Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them, and whose sins you retain are retained."

Thomas, called Didymus, one of the Twelve, was not with them when Jesus came. So the other disciples said to him, "We have seen the Lord." But he said to them, "Unless I see the mark of the nails in his hands and put my finger into the nailmarks and put my hand into his side, I will not believe."

Now a week later his disciples were again inside and Thomas was with them. Jesus came, although the doors were locked, and stood in their midst and said, "Peace be with you." Then he said to Thomas, "Put your finger here and see my hands, and bring your hand and put it into my side, and do not be unbelieving, but believe." Thomas answered and said to him, "My Lord and my God!" Jesus said to him, "Have you come to believe because you have seen me? Blessed are those who have not seen and have believed."

Now Jesus did many other signs in the presence of his disciples that are not written in this book. But these are written that you may come to believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that through this belief you may have life in his name.

Easter Sunday Second Mercy Crazy

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

The Sunday after Easter has always been called, "The Second Sunday of Easter." Officially, it still is. It is part of the Easter Octave. We celebrate 8 days as one BIG Easter Sunday! ALLELUIA!

Pope John Paul II gave this Sunday a second name: "Divine Mercy Sunday," a day to focus on and celebrate the God's unlimited mercy that comes to us through the Sacred Heart of the Risen Christ! Many on this day will pray the Chaplet of the Divine Mercy.

If I were permitted to give this Sunday another name, I would call it "Crazy for Christ Sunday." (You can see why I will never be pope.)

Look at this Sunday's Scriptures: In the Gospel, the disciple Thomas thinks his friends are crazy for believing Jesus Christ has risen from the dead. Then, he joins them and believes, too! Tradition says Thomas will go as far as India to preach the Gospel! Wow! Some might call that going crazy for Christ!

In our first reading from the Acts of the Apostles, we read how the first generation of Christians did not claim their possessions as their own. They held everything in common, going so far as to selling their property and houses, giving the proceeds to a common fund so the money could be distributed to those who were most in need. Wow, again! That's doing something crazy for Christ!

So filled with Easter Joy and the love of Christ, these Christians did crazy (not reckless) things to witness to their faith in the Risen Lord. They put their money where their mouth ... and heart ... was. It was this kind of crazy, merciful love, based on faith in Christ, that helped convert dozens, hundreds, eventually thousands and millions of people.

I can think of no better way to celebrate this Second Sunday of Easter & Divine Mercy, than by doing a little something crazy for Christ ourselves. Let me know what you come up with.
