GOSPEL JOHN 24:35-48

The two disciples recounted what had taken place on the way, and how Jesus was made known to them in the breaking of bread.

While they were still speaking about this, he stood in their midst and said to them, "Peace be with you." But they were startled and terrified and thought that they were seeing a ghost. Then he said to them, "Why are you troubled? And why do questions arise in your hearts? Look at my hands and my feet, that it is I myself. Touch me and see, because a ghost does not have flesh and bones as you can see I have." And as he said this, he showed them his hands and his feet. While they were still incredulous for joy and were amazed, he asked them, "Have you anything here to eat?" They gave him a piece of baked fish; he took it and ate it in front of them.

He said to them, "These are my words that I spoke to you while I was still with you, that everything written about me in the law of Moses and in the prophets and psalms must be fulfilled." Then he opened their minds to understand the Scriptures. And he said to them, "Thus it is written that the Christ would suffer and rise from the dead on the third day and that repentance, for the forgiveness of sins, would be preached in his name to all the nations, beginning from Jerusalem. You are witnesses of these things.

Limited perhaps in how many could attend in person, but certainly nothing can limit God's incredible love for us that goes even beyond death! Jesus Christ is risen ... and real ... **and here!**

Another note, this one a note of deep gratitude. I want to offer my sincere and heartfelt appreciation to all who contributed to our Easter offering. I wish I could write to each of you individually to thank you personally for your continued and incredibly generous support of our parish ... especially during these difficult times. Your generosity both amazes and humbles me. Thank you so very much.

Last note: As you may have heard, beginning this weekend, prior registration is not required for Sunday Masses (it has not been required for daily Mass for quite some time). Masks and social distancing, however, are still required. We will continue to sanitize the church as thoroughly as we have been doing after each Mass. Church capacity will continue to be limited; we will also provide "overflow" seating in Pedata Hall if we go over the limit. I ask everyone's continued cooperation. Let's continue to be helpful and kind to one another, doing our best to make everyone safe and also feel comfortable in church. Be assured, if the numbers are too large, I will go back to requiring registration, if not for all Masses, then at least for the most heavily attended.

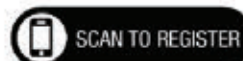
