Good Shepherd Sunday

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

I know the English like to eat Shepherd's Pie. Even though I have a little English in me — my mother is a Horner, which reminds me of Little Jack who sat in a corner and stuck his thumb in a Christmas pie — I've never been a fan of pie with lamb inside, or plums for that matter! Evidently, however, that's how Shepherd's pie got its name: it has lamb meat in it.

That poor lamb.

That is the thing about lambs, isn't it? They give and they give. They give the very coat off their backs so that others can be warm in the cold winter months. Many give their very lives so we can eat shepherd's pie and lamb stew and lamb chops. (If you are a vegan or vegetarian, stay with me. There is a point here.)

Here is the point: Our Good and Chief Shepherd, Jesus, gave of himself completely, giving His life so we might live forever (which is why, by the way, we also call Jesus, the "Lamb of God"). My job, as a little shepherd, is to do no less. In fact, all of us as disciples of Jesus, as members of Christ's Body, are called to do the same: give of ourselves, give the shirt and the coat off our back, give our time, give our talents, give our resources, give our hearts and minds and wills in service to God and neighbor.

Here is the point in less words: all the attributes that make the Good Shepherd good, are the same attributes that will make all of us good Christians.

The pandemic and quarantine affected all of our lives and it also had a powerful impact on the Sacramental life of our parish.

Weddings for the most part were postponed.

Baptisms had to be celebrated one baby at a time (this is still the case).

First Communion was celebrated with a very limited amount of family present and the children wore masks (they will always remember that!).

Confirmation with our 9th Graders had to be postponed.

Saddest of all, we were not permitted to visit the sick and dying, and many people held off making funeral arrangements for loved ones.

Thankfully, things are slowly changing for the better. More people can join us inside the church for Mass and we are now, in most cases, able to anoint the sick and dying in hospitals and other institutions.

St. Joan of Arc is not about numbers, but they do tell a story.

And last year's story is one we will tell for a very long time.

IMPORTANT MESSAGE ABOUT SUNDAY MASS

As of April 17/18, pre-registration for Sunday Masses is no longer required at the Church of St. Joan of Arc. If, however, attendance reaches the point where social distancing is not possible, we will return to pre-registration.

Our goal is to welcome as many people to Mass as possible while maintaining a safe environment. Therefore, please keep in mind:

- ⇒ Masks must still be worn to every Mass, Sunday and daily.
- ⇒ Please continue to keep social distance.
- ⇒ We will sanitize the Church after each Mass.
- ⇒ The 10:30am Sunday Mass, as well as all 9am daily Masses, will continue to be livestreamed.
