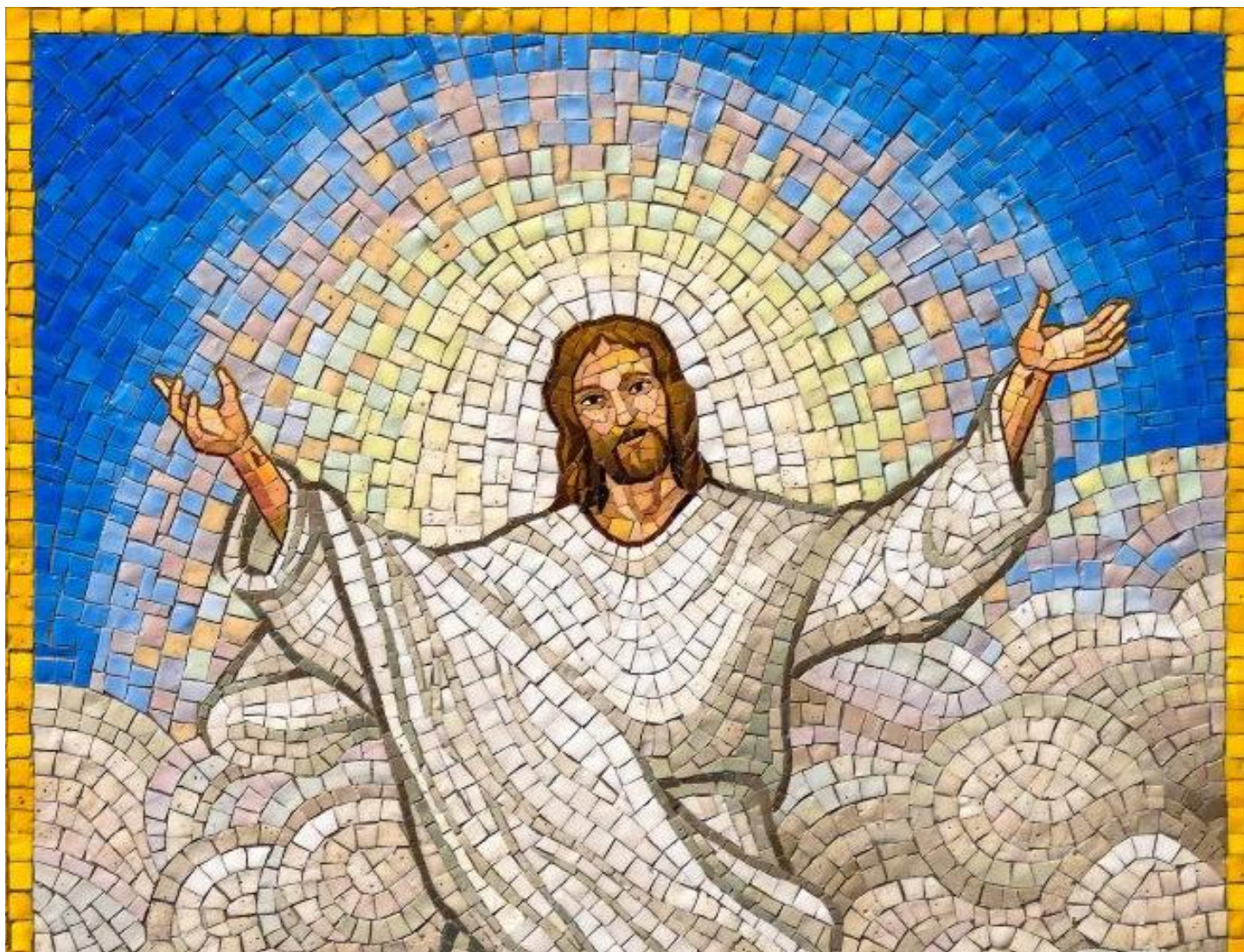

## THE FORGOTTEN FEAST

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

It's good to be realistic — at least from time to time! Very few people were attending the Feast of the Ascension when it was celebrated every year as a Holy Day of Obligation on the 40th day after Easter, which is always a Thursday. That's the fact: it was a very poorly attended Holy Day. I don't know whose fault that is. Maybe mine as pastor. Maybe people just forgot. Maybe getting to a Holy Day Mass in the middle of the week is tough for working people.

Because people didn't go, very few people know what the Ascension is all about. This is why I am glad it is on a Sunday this year. Like last year, the Bishops of New Jersey, because of the pandemic, have chosen to once again move it to the Sunday before Pentecost. Personally, I wish our Bishops would make the move permanent (just like the vast majority of dioceses across the planet have already done!).

The Ascension is part of the Paschal (Easter) Mystery! Without the Ascension, there is no Pentecost. Without the Ascension, therefore, there would be no Church. Jesus rises and returns to the Father and sends the Holy Spirit so that we, His disciples, can live as His Body on earth.

It turns out, in leaving His disciples, Jesus empowers them "to go into the whole world to proclaim the Gospel!" Although Jesus leaves them, He does not leave them alone. Nor us. We have the Spirit of the Lord within us. The work of Jesus Christ continues today, now, through us.

So, the Ascension leads to Pentecost which we will celebrate together next Sunday. I can't wait. I hope you can't either.
