GOSPEL JOHN 15:1-8

Jesus said to his disciples:

"I am the true vine, and my Father is the vine grower. He takes away every branch in me that does not bear fruit, and every one that does he prunes so that it bears more fruit. You are already pruned because of the word that I spoke to you. Remain in me, as I remain in you. Just as a branch cannot bear fruit on its own unless it remains on the vine, so neither can you unless you remain in me. I am the vine, you are the branches. Whoever remains in me and I in him will bear much fruit, because without me you can do nothing. Anyone who does not remain in me will be thrown out like a branch and wither; people will gather them and throw them into a fire and they will be burned. If you remain in me and my words remain in you, ask for whatever you want and it will be done for you. By this is my Father glorified, that you bear much fruit and become my disciples."

The Vine and the First Sacrament

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

This Sunday I have the privilege of baptizing my first great niece, Mae Isabelle. She is the daughter of my nephew, Paul, and his lovely wife, Andrea. Every baptism, of course, is a great joy, but this one, I must admit, will hold a special place in my heart.

Little Mae will be baptized on a Sunday in the Easter Season when the Gospel speaks, appropriately, I think, of vines and branches. In the wonderful sacrament of baptism, the first we celebrate, a person gets tangled up in the life of Jesus Christ and His Church. "Tangled up" in a good way, I might add.

In baptism we are made one with Christ our Savior in a bond that cannot be broken — neither sinfulness nor even death can destroy this relationship! At the same time, in baptism we become enmeshed in the life of the Church, the Body of Christ on earth, its people and its mission. We are therefore both spiritually *and* physically one with Christ.

Little Mae, of course, has never been alone since her birth. Her parents and grandparents adore her. She has been photographed more than any Hollywood star. Now, in baptism, we celebrate a promise given to her by God, the author of life, Himself. She will never be alone ... no matter what life brings, and we know, those of us with some years behind us, we know life can bring all sorts of challenges. Many of these challenges can cause us to question ourselves, who we are, who we belong to, what is important, what all of this — life — means. It will be this entanglement with Christ that saves Mae.

Yes, Christ is the vine and we are the branches. In baptism, a new branch buds and begins to grow and reach out. Mae will always belong, she will always have a purpose and a mission. She will wear Christ and bring Christ to every situation in her life, happy or sad. And she will do this not alone, but very much connected to a larger community, entangled in its hopes and fears and strengths and shortcomings, a community that has experienced so much and has so much wisdom and love to share with her.

This is no less so for each of us.
