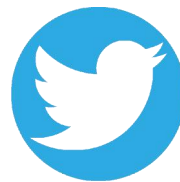

GOSPEL MARK 5: 21-43

When Jesus had crossed again in the boat to the other side, a large crowd gathered around him, and he stayed close to the sea. One of the synagogue officials, named Jairus, came forward. Seeing him he fell at his feet and pleaded earnestly with him, saying, "My daughter is at the point of death. Please, come lay your hands on her that she may get well and live." He went off with him, and a large crowd followed him and pressed upon him. There was a woman afflicted with hemorrhages for twelve years. She had suffered greatly at the hands of many doctors and had spent all that she had. Yet she was not helped but only grew worse. She had heard about Jesus and came up behind him in the crowd and touched his cloak. She said, "If I but touch his clothes, I shall be cured." Immediately her flow of blood dried up. She felt in her body that she was healed of her affliction. Jesus, aware at once that power had gone out from him, turned around in the crowd and asked, "Who has touched my clothes?" But his disciples said to Jesus, "You see how the crowd is pressing upon you, and yet you ask, 'Who touched me?'" And he looked around to see who had done it. The woman, realizing what had happened to her, approached in fear and trembling. She fell down before Jesus and told him the whole truth. He said to her, "Daughter, your faith has saved you. Go in peace and be cured of your affliction." While he was still speaking, people from the synagogue official's house arrived and said, "Your daughter has died; why trouble the teacher any longer?" Disregarding the message that was reported, Jesus said to the synagogue official, "Do not be afraid; just have faith." He did not allow anyone to accompany him inside except Peter, James, and John, the brother of James. When they arrived at the house of the synagogue official, he caught sight of a commotion, people weeping and wailing loudly. So he went in and said to them, "Why this commotion and weeping? The child is not dead but asleep." And they ridiculed him. Then he put them all out. He took along the child's father and mother and those who were with him and entered the room where the child was. He took the child by the hand and said to her, "*Talitha koum,*" which means, "Little girl, I say to you, arise!" The girl, a child of twelve, arose immediately and walked around. At that they were utterly astounded. He gave strict orders that no one should know this and said that she should be given something to eat.

13th Sunday in Ordinary Time/2021 A Weekend and a Future

Dear Parishioners and Friends,
Last Friday I had the privilege of celebrating two weddings with two terrific couples. Earlier in the day, I presided at a funeral. The next day, I baptized two beautiful babies surrounded by their joyful families. I also participated in a graveside service with a family who lost a loved one in March of 2020. Also, I was honored to witness the renewal of wedding vows of Henry and Theresa Vitullo who were married 50 years ago to the day. In between these liturgies, I stood with families at the bedside of a loved one who was dying and another who had just passed. On Sunday, I gathered with hundreds of people at three Masses, hearing God's Word address faith during stormy times. We blessed Dads, we celebrated the Eucharist, we lifted up our hearts to thank God, to pray for the world, to think about things that really matter.
After all this, I had two thoughts. Here's the first:
Why do men not want to be priests? Why do so few want to have a weekend like I just had? I'm sure it's not secret to you that I personally wish women could also be ordained, but even if they could be, I wonder if any would want to do it? If men don't; why would women?
But why not?
In what other "job" is there the opportunity to be with people – to really *be* with them – during some of the most significant, life-changing events, the moments that touch our hearts, that open our eyes, that move us in new directions, that speak to the soul? In what other "job" can you gather with people of every age, every background, every opinion, and help them, together, encounter the life-giving presence and love of God? It is a wonderful calling. I would love to talk to anyone who thinks they might have it.
Here's thought #2:
As we wait for a new associate pastor to arrive later this week, what I have just experienced as the only priest in the parish is the way it is in many parishes around the country and throughout the world every day. This is the way it is going to be for the foreseeable future. Having an associate pastor is a luxury that few parishes and pastors get to have nowadays. So, let's welcome Father John Michael Patilla with grateful hearts this week. He is truly a blessing! Let's also prepare for the day when we are not so fortunate.

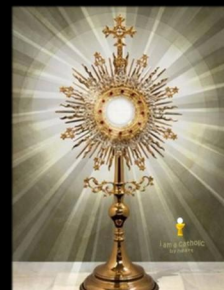

WHAT TO EXPECT AT MASS:

- **Everyone is invited to return to Mass!!** There is no room capacity limit. All pews (but two) are now open. Pre-registration is not required.
- **Those who are ill** are not required to come to Mass. (In fact, as we have learned, it is an act of kindness and sacrifice to keep others healthy by remaining home. Thank you!)
- We will continue to **sanitize** the church every day.
- Sanitizing stations will be at every entrance. We ask you to **sanitize your hands** upon entering and exiting the church building.
- **Masks** are optional for those who are fully vaccinated. No one will be judged for wearing a mask.
- The **Mass Schedule** remains the same (no Noon Mass yet ... thanks for your patience!)
- Every Mass will be **simulcast in Pedata Hall** for those who might be more comfortable there.
- The 10:30am Mass will continue to be **live streamed** for those not able to come to church.
- The return of the opening and closing processions, more music and the "regular" Communion lines.
- **Ministers of Communion** must wear a mask while distributing the Sacrament.
- We will continue to share the **Sign of Peace** as we have been doing.
- During the summer months, **altar servers** who wish to volunteer and serve may do so at their own choosing. Please see the priest before Mass begins. Scheduling of altar servers will begin in September.
- For the time being, **collection boxes** will continue to be used for your weekly offering.
- **Votive candles** may be lit; **poor boxes** may be used, and **Holy water fonts** will be wet again!
You will see other practices return as time goes on. Thank you for your patience & cooperation!
