

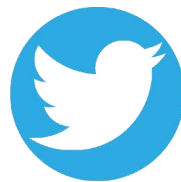

## 16<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time/2021

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

Lot of "sheep and shepherd talk" going on in today's first reading from the prophet Jeremiah (23:1-6), as well as in Mark's Gospel (6:30-34), and also in the Responsorial Psalm which is taken from the 23rd where we find, hands down the best known pastoral reference in the Bible, "the Lord is my shepherd."

My shepherd ... and your shepherd, too. *Our* shepherd.

That, in fact, seems to be the point of the second reading (Ephesians 2:13-18) where, ironically, neither shepherd nor sheep are mentioned. Jesus came to unite, not to scatter. One shepherd, one flock.

Nowadays we hear a lot of "division talk," how divided we are as a nation, even as a Church. It sometimes seems, from my admittedly limited perspective, we are only *not* divided when facing a crisis; then, as the crisis subsides, it is back to the divisions.

Is there not a way to live united every day?

The work of Jesus is always to heal, reconcile, mend and make one human family. We who are baptized into Christ Jesus acquire this same work. It is our mission. Every day.
