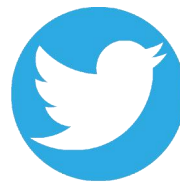

So he was not able to perform any mighty deed there, apart from curing a few sick people by laying his hands on them. He was amazed at their lack of faith.

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

This weekend we welcome Father John Michael (JM) Patilla to the Church of St. Joan of Arc! Fr. JM will serve as the 36th Associate Pastor in the 60 year history of our parish! He comes after serving 5 years at St. Benedict's Parish in Holmdel (I probably don't need to tell you that because most of you have already Googled him!).

Later this week, on Tuesday, we will also be blessed with arrival of Mrs. Jessica Donohue, our new Director of Religious Education (she will be our 5th in 60 years!). I had the pleasure of working with Mrs. Donohue on a Diocesan Commission several years ago. I am thrilled that she will be part of our Pastoral Staff and working with the young people.

Please keep Father JM and Jessica in your prayers as they begin their respective ministries here.

You may have noticed the arrival of two new screens inside our church over the exit doors to the left and right of the Sanctuary. At its June meeting, our Parish Pastoral Council unanimously recommended to me that we have screens installed in order to enhance our liturgy. I have obviously accepted this recommendation. *Enhancement* is key. Our Liturgy Team will compose guidelines for how they are to be used during Mass so that they do not become a distraction. The goal is to promote "full, conscious and active participation" in the Liturgy. Please accept my apologies that I did not inform you of this before the installation of the screens; it's rare, but sometimes things go ahead of schedule!

And, lastly, the arrival Fourth of July! I hope your holiday weekend is safe and enjoyable. We are truly blessed to live in this great land! Today we pray in thanksgiving for the freedom we have and for those who dreamed of it and made it a reality, as well as for those who have defended it and given their lives securing it. May God bless this country!

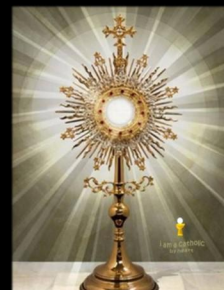

WHAT TO EXPECT AT MASS:

- **Everyone is invited to return to Mass!!** There is no room capacity limit. All pews (but two) are now open. Pre-registration is not required.
 - **Those who are ill** are not required to come to Mass. (In fact, as we have learned, it is an act of kindness and sacrifice to keep others healthy by remaining home. Thank you!)
 - We will continue to **sanitize** the church every day.
 - Sanitizing stations will be at every entrance. We ask you to **sanitize your hands** upon entering and exiting the church building.
 - **Masks** are optional for those who are fully vaccinated. No one will be judged for wearing a mask.
 - The **Mass Schedule** remains the same (no Noon Mass yet ... thanks for your patience!)
 - Every Mass will be **simulcast in Pedata Hall** for those who might be more comfortable there.
 - The 10:30am Mass will continue to be **live streamed** for those not able to come to church.
 - The return of the opening and closing processions, more music and the "regular" Communion lines.
 - **Ministers of Communion** must wear a mask while distributing the Sacrament.
 - We will continue to share the **Sign of Peace** as we have been doing.
 - During the summer months, **altar servers** who wish to volunteer and serve may do so at their own choosing. Please see the priest before Mass begins. Scheduling of altar servers will begin in September.
 - For the time being, **collection boxes** will continue to be used for your weekly offering.
 - **Votive candles** may be lit; **poor boxes** may be used, and **Holy water fonts** will be wet again!
