

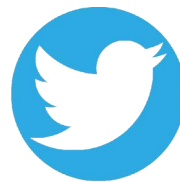

## GOSPEL JOHN 6: 24-35

When the crowd saw that neither Jesus nor his disciples were there, they themselves got into boats and came to Capernaum looking for Jesus. And when they found him across the sea they said to him, "Rabbi, when did you get here?" Jesus answered them and said, "Amen, amen, I say to you, you are looking for me not because you saw signs but because you ate the loaves and were filled. Do not work for food that perishes but for the food that endures for eternal life, which the Son of Man will give you. For on him the Father, God, has set his seal." So they said to him, "What can we do to accomplish the works of God?" Jesus answered and said to them, "This is the work of God, that you believe in the one he sent." So they said to him, "What sign can you do, that we may see and believe in you? What can you do? Our ancestors ate manna in the desert, as it is written: *He gave them bread from heaven to eat.*" So Jesus said to them, "Amen, amen, I say to you, it was not Moses who gave the bread from heaven; my Father gives you the true bread from heaven. For the bread of God is that which comes down from heaven and gives life to the world." So they said to him, "Sir, give us this bread always." Jesus said to them, "I am the bread of life; whoever comes to me will never hunger, and whoever believes in me will never thirst."

## BREAD FROM HEAVEN

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

It has been wonderful to see people coming back to Mass. Each week I meet someone who tells me this is their "first Mass" in person since the start of the pandemic back in March of 2020. Let's continue to hope and pray that more and more people are vaccinated, that COVID-19 and its variants are defeated and that more and more people return to Mass.

For the Bread of Life. For the Eucharist.

The Eucharist, as you know, is "the heart and the summit of the Church's life, for in it Christ associates his Church and all her members with his sacrifice of praise and thanksgiving offered once for all on the cross to his Father; by this sacrifice he pours out the graces of salvation on his Body which is the Church." (Catechism 1407)

In the Eucharist we remember and celebrate all that God has done for us in Christ; namely, our salvation which is "accomplished by the life, death, and resurrection of Christ, a work made present by the liturgical action." (Catechism 1409)

As our Catechism tells us, "It is Christ himself, the eternal high priest of the New Covenant who, acting through the ministry of the priests, offers the Eucharistic sacrifice. And it is the same Christ, really present under the species of bread and wine, who is the offering of the Eucharistic sacrifice." (1410)

This is the heart of what we believe: "Under the consecrated species of bread and wine Christ himself, living and glorious, is present in a true, real, and substantial manner: his Body and his Blood, with his soul and his divinity." (1413) This is what we mean when we speak of Real Presence ... the real presence of Christ in the Eucharist.

It is my hope that as more and more people return to Sunday Mass, we will all grow in our love and understanding of the Eucharist, the Sacrament in which Christ gives us His body and blood, and in doing so, strengthens us to live who we became in baptism: His very body here on earth.

Reading our Catechism will help us (begin with paragraph 1322). But before that, read and re-read Chapter 6 of the Gospel of John. In this chapter you will hear Jesus' own words. Let Him tell you what this means. Hear Him say, "I am the Bread of Life, the Bread come down from heaven." This, ultimately, is why we believe what we do.

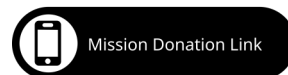
