GOSPEL MARK 8: 27-35

Jesus and his disciples set out for the villages of Caesarea Philippi. Along the way he asked his disciples, "Who do people say that I am?" They said in reply, "John the Baptist, others Elijah, still others one of the prophets." And he asked them, "But who do you say that I am?" Peter said to him in reply, "You are the Christ." Then he warned them not to tell anyone about him. He began to teach them that the Son of Man must suffer greatly and be rejected by the elders, the chief priests, and the scribes, and be killed, and rise after three days. He spoke this openly. Then Peter took him aside and began to rebuke him. At this he turned around and, looking at his disciples, rebuked Peter and said, "Get behind me, Satan. You are thinking not as God does, but as human beings do." He summoned the crowd with his disciples and said to them, "Whoever wishes to come after me must deny himself, take up his cross, and follow me. For whoever wishes to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for my sake and that of the gospel will save it."

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

I was preparing to go into a funeral Mass on the morning of September 11th twenty years ago when I received word of what was happening in New York City. No doubt, if you are old enough, you remember what you were doing too.

We remember the horror of that day, the incredible sadness that followed, a nation grieving.

We also remember the incredible sacrifice of so many who thought nothing of their own safety but only how they might help and save others. "Take up your cross and follow me," Jesus says in today's Gospel. Firefighters and other first responders who rushed into those towers twenty years ago, did exactly that. Without a second thought.

As we remember and grieve ... we give thanks. We are all made better by such courage and sacrifice.

It has been a different world since that day. There is much to consider, to learn, for us as a country and as a world. And, also, as people of faith, as believers.

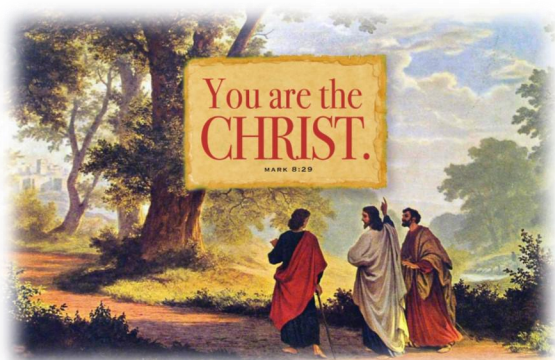
In today's Gospel Jesus sets foot into a town named for Caesar. Tellingly, it is here that Peter makes a stunning declaration of faith. "You are the Christ," he says to Jesus. Christ! The Anointed One! It is Jesus Christ who is God's Anointed One ... not Tiberius Caesar or any other Caesar. Jesus the Christ is the Alpha and Omega, the Beginning and the End, the Lord of all history.

As people of faith, we look to Jesus Christ to discover God's plan and hope and dream for the world we live in. Dark times will never overshadow the goodness and mercy and justice of the One God who is the fountain of all life and love. Let's take up our cross, the cross of Christ, and follow Him into the future God wants to give us, a time and place when all people live as one, where all people call each other brothers and sisters.

We remember. We grieve. We give thanks. We follow the Christ.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

We are excited for the 2021-2022 Religious Education year to start! We are looking for catechists and aides who would like to teach 7th or 8th grade in person, and catechists who would like to teach virtually in grades 3rd through 6th!

- **In-Person Teaching** - Due to current circumstances, we are offering in-person classes every other week for grades 1st, 2nd, 7th and 8th, beginning October 4th/5th. Catechists will give students assignments to complete on the weeks they are not in the classroom. 7th and 8th grades are the years when we prepare our children for the Sacrament of Confirmation, so these are particularly vital (and fun!) years to teach.
