

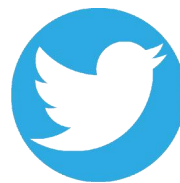

GOD'S GOOD & FAITHFUL SERVANT!

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

By the time I arrived at St. Joan of Arc Parish in March of 2007, Sr. Eleanor O'Connell, SSJ, had already been serving here as a Pastoral Associate for 19 years! Consider this: from 1988 until 2012, if you became Catholic through RCIA, you were instructed and guided by Sr. Eleanor ... if you had a Funeral Mass here, it was Sr. Eleanor who welcomed your family to the Church ... if you went on a bus trip, it was Sr. Eleanor who booked it ... if you attended an Adult Faith Enrichment Program (which occurred monthly since 1988), it was Sr. Eleanor who helped plan it ... if you went to a Wednesday morning Bible Study or a Tuesday night Bereavement Group gathering, it was Sr. Eleanor who led it.

I would call Sr. Eleanor an institution here at St. Joan of Arc, but that sounds much too impersonal. Sr. Eleanor was never impersonal. She was caring and compassionate, bright and insightful. She enjoyed a good laugh; she was a great storyteller. She was very organized and an incredibly hard worker. She was a terrific teacher and a faithful "companion on the journey." Sr. Eleanor got things done and she got people involved in the doing of things.

In so many ways, Sr. Eleanor fully embraced the challenge given by Vatican II to help empower lay people, to involve them in the mission of Jesus Christ and His Church. I know dozens and dozens of people who will say they are a better disciple of Jesus because of the influence of Sr. Eleanor. This parish is strong and vibrant because of Sr. Eleanor.

All this and she loved to golf! And she was one classy dresser! In fact, everything Sr. Eleanor did, she did with grace and excellence!

She has been missed here at our parish. In fact, I daresay, the whole Church misses Sr. Eleanor and the many Sisters of her generation who gave their entire lives in service to God's people, helping to build and run parishes, schools, hospitals and so many different ministries. Sisters like Eleanor O'Connell could have run large corporations, but they chose instead not to pursue their own dreams, but to live in community and dedicate themselves to making God's dream for the world a reality.

On Sunday, September 12th, just after the noon hour, Sr. Eleanor O'Connell, a Sister of St. Joseph, in the year of St. Joseph, left this world to enter the Heart of God. Our hearts will forever be grateful for having known her, loved her, worked beside her, laughed with her and learned so much from her. Sr. Eleanor, thank you! Rest now in peace ... until we meet again!

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

We are excited for the 2021-2022 Religious Education year to start! We are looking for catechists and aides who would like to teach 7th or 8th grade in person, and catechists who would like to teach virtually in grades 3rd through 6th!

- **In-Person Teaching** - Due to current circumstances, we are offering in-person classes every other week for grades 1st, 2nd, 7th and 8th, beginning October 4th/5th. Catechists will give students assignments to complete on the weeks they are not in the classroom. 7th and 8th grades are the years when we prepare our children for the Sacrament of Confirmation, so these are particularly vital (and fun!) years to teach.

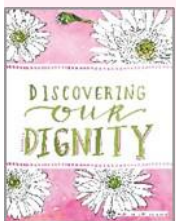
We invite you to consider joining **Walking with Purpose**, a women's Catholic Bible study, right here at Saint Joan of Arc. Interested in learning more?

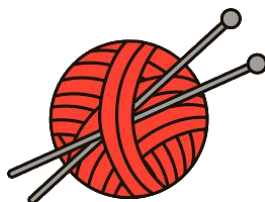
PRAYER SHAWL MINISTRY

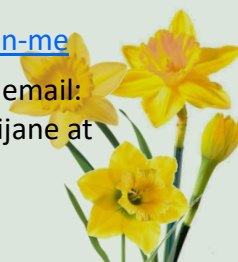
