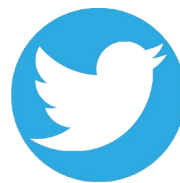

## GOSPEL MARK 7: 31-37

Again Jesus left the district of Tyre and went by way of Sidon to the Sea of Galilee, into the district of the Decapolis. And people brought to him a deaf man who had a speech impediment and begged him to lay his hand on him. He took him off by himself away from the crowd. He put his finger into the man's ears and, spitting, touched his tongue; then he looked up to heaven and groaned, and said to him, "Ephphatha!" — that is, "Be opened!" — And immediately the man's ears were opened, his speech impediment was removed, and he spoke plainly. He ordered them not to tell anyone. But the more he ordered them not to, the more they proclaimed it. They were exceedingly astonished and they said, "He has done all things well. He makes the deaf hear and the mute speak."

## JESUS THE HEALER

Dear Parishioners and Friends:

I know we use the word "save" a lot when we speak in terms of Jesus Christ. Jesus came to save us. He is indeed our Savior. In fact, He is the Savior of the world, of all humanity, past, present and future.

One title I do not use often enough is Healer. And yet, a journey through the four Gospels will see Jesus constantly healing people. We see an example of it in today's passage from Mark (7:31-37). Jesus heals a man with hearing loss and a speech impediment. Time and again, he is healing the sick, restoring them to wholeness, helping them take a step forward to the fullness of life. When I reflect on this, I am seeing more and more that this is *how* Jesus saves us ... by healing us, usually from the inside out.

Because it isn't just our physical bodies that need this healing. Our spirit and soul needs healing; our thinking, our dispositions and decisions; our relationships, too, our families and communities. So does the world! Perhaps in terms of evangelization, in talking to people who do not understand or believe they need a Savior, I believe there would be few people who honestly would say there isn't some part of their life, or the world's, that needs to be healed, mended, restored to wholeness.

Jesus shows us, in his birth, life, ministry, suffering and death how to do this! And, as Christ's Body on earth, we the Church have the mission to participate in his healing love.

We have been trying to do exactly this during this pandemic. In light of this, I've decided to postpone our return to Community Sunday. We will take it month to month. Believe me, no one wants to bring back Sunday donuts more than me! It will happen. In the meantime, let's continue to work with our Savior, Jesus Christ, the healer of the world!

## RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

We are excited for the 2021-2022 Religious Education year to start! We are looking for catechists and aides who would like to teach 7<sup>th</sup> or 8<sup>th</sup> grade in person, and catechists who would like to teach virtually in grades 3<sup>rd</sup> through 6<sup>th</sup>!

- **In-Person Teaching** - Due to current circumstances, we are offering in-person classes every other week for grades 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup>, beginning October 4<sup>th</sup>/5<sup>th</sup>. Catechists will give students assignments to complete on the weeks they are not in the classroom. 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grades are the years when we prepare our children for the Sacrament of Confirmation, so these are particularly vital (and fun!) years to teach.

- **Virtual Teaching** - If you are looking for a volunteer opportunity that has some flexibility built into it, teaching virtually might be a great fit since you can do everything from the comfort of your own home! Catechists will meet virtually for 15-30 minutes each week on a Monday or Tuesday for grades 3<sup>rd</sup> - 6<sup>th</sup> beginning in October, and will use the Google Classroom platform to post resources and assignments for their students. *A class on how to use Google Classroom is being provided here at St. Joan's - it's easier than you think!*

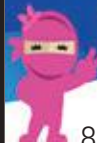
