## GOSPEL MARK 10: 35-45

James and John, the sons of Zebedee, came to Jesus and said to him, "Teacher, we want you to do for us whatever we ask of you." He replied, "What do you wish me to do for you?" They answered him, "Grant that in your glory we may sit one at your right and the other at your left." Jesus said to them, "You do not know what you are asking. Can you drink the cup that I drink or be baptized with the baptism with which I am baptized?" They said to him, "We can." Jesus said to them, "The cup that I drink, you will drink, and with the baptism with which I am baptized, you will be baptized; but to sit at my right or at my left is not mine to give but is for those for whom it has been prepared." When the ten heard this, they became indignant at James and John. ## SYNOD, ANYONE?

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

Ever been to a Synod? You've probably heard the word in Catholic Church-talk, but most of us are not overly familiar with it. Well, get ready, because if you have or haven't heard of it before, we are all invited to participate in some fashion in the next Synod called by Pope Francis for 2023.

A Synod is a gathering of bishops to discuss a particular topic relevant to the Universal Church. The Second Vatican Council called established these Synods as a regular part of Church-life. The Synod is used as a means of listening to the voice of Christ alive in each member of the Church. It is a process to gather Christ's disciples and to hear their voices.

The theme of the next Synod is "**For a Synodal Church: Communion, Participation and Mission**" and it will be a little bit different than others in that there will be many more chances on the Diocesan, that is the local, level to participate. You will hear much more about this in the months to come.

Preparation and involvement in the Synodal process began last weekend in Rome and continues this weekend. Last Sunday, the Pope celebrated Mass in the Vatican opening the Synodal preparation. This Sunday, in every Diocese around the around — including ours — the local Bishop will gather to celebrate Mass in the Cathedral to begin the local process. Our Mass with Bishop O'Connell is this Sunday, October 17<sup>th</sup> at 3pm in the Cathedral in Trenton. All are invited to participate. This Mass will also begin a year of celebrating the 140<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Trenton Diocese.

**Communion. Participation. Mission.** It is my hope that we talk more about the meaning of these words and how to live them in a practical way here in our parish.

May the Holy Spirit guide and direct and inspire the Church here in New Jersey, here in Marlton, and around the world as we dialogue and learn from each other, all of us growing together in our discipleship, in our commitment to follow Jesus Christ and to continue His work in the world.

## BEING CHURCH TOGETHER. MORE ON THE UPCOMING SYNOD

Bishop O'Connell has written a **Pastoral Letter** explaining the upcoming Synod of the Catholic Church, called for by Pope Francis, with will include the participation of every Diocese in the world. "An integral part of the diocesan synodal journey itself with its principal theme of 'communion, participate, mission,' is the effort to reach out to as many Catholics of the Diocese as possible: clergy and consecrated religious, active as well as 'lapsed' or non-practicing Catholic lay faithful women and men, both married and single, of every generation, race, national and ethnic background, different point of view, social, political and economic status. In other words, all those who have in the past or still call the Catholic Church "home" are called to actively participate in the synodality of the Church by pausing to listen to one another on this journey together.

"Some questions and points of reflection for all the participants described above include: what has been/is your experience of the Catholic Church? How has that experience shaped or affected your life and your faith in God? What obstacles to worship, learning and service have you encountered that may have negatively influenced the practice of your Catholic faith? What do you need as a Catholic to be a stronger, more intentional, more committed, more connected member of the Church, to belong and feel like you belong to the Church? How can we better "journey together" as Catholics in Mercer, Burlington, Ocean and Monmouth counties?"

### INHERITING THE KINGDOM OF GOD

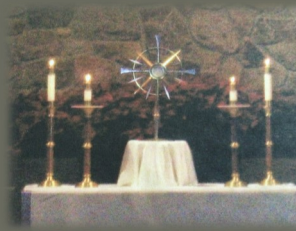

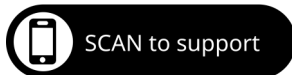

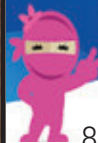
