

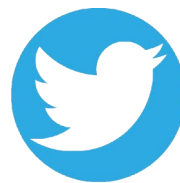

He threw aside his cloak, sprang up, and came to Jesus. Jesus said to him in reply, "What do you want me to do for you?" The blind man replied to him, "Master, I want to see." Jesus told him, "Go your way; your faith has saved you." Immediately he received his sight and followed him on the way.

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

Sometimes — not too often — when we celebrate a funeral Mass for someone who was a big fan of Frank Sinatra, the deceased's family will request "My Way" to be sung at the recessional.

I get it. I am also a Sinatra fan. I know "My Way" was one of Frank's signature songs. It's an inspiring tune. But, honestly, I cringe a bit when it is requested for a funeral in Church. I want to say as kindly as possible, "Pick another."

It's the **my** part that gets me. **My** way just doesn't seem the right sentiment in Church. Shouldn't it be **God's** way? Shouldn't disciples of Jesus do it **Christ's** way?

Listen to today's Gospel (Mark 10: 45-52). After healing a blind man, Jesus says to the fellow: "Go your way." Interesting, right? But right after that, we are told, Bartimaeus, the name of the blind man now cured, follows Jesus.

**The Way** was a nickname for Christianity in the early days.

Jesus says in John's Gospel that **He** is the way, the truth and the life.

We can try going through life doing things our way, but it is only when we do things **His** way, that we find the fullness of peace, joy and life. Sorry, Frank.

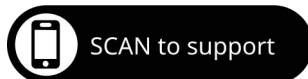


