GOSPEL MARK 10: 2-16

The Pharisees approached Jesus and asked, "Is it lawful for a husband to divorce his wife?" They were testing him. He said to them in reply, "What did Moses command you?" They replied, "Moses permitted a husband to write a bill of divorce and dismiss her." But Jesus told them, "Because of the hardness of your hearts he wrote you this commandment. But from the beginning of creation, God made them male and female. *For this reason a man shall leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh.* So they are no longer two but one flesh. Therefore what God has joined together, no human being must separate." In the house the disciples again questioned Jesus about this. He said to them, "Whoever divorces his wife and marries another commits adultery against her; and if she divorces her husband and marries another, she commits adultery." And people were bringing children to him that he might touch them, but the disciples rebuked them. When Jesus saw this he became indignant and said to them, "Let the children come to me; do not prevent them, for the kingdom of God belongs to such as these. Amen, I say to you, whoever does not accept the kingdom of God like a child will not enter it." Then he embraced them and blessed them, placing his hands on them.

ALL LIFE IS SACRED

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

This Sunday begins Respect Life Month, a month during which we highlight the sacredness of every human life, in every stage of life from conception until death. This is not a teaching the Catholic Church pulled out of mid-air. This teaching comes from our Sacred Scriptures and from Jesus Christ himself.

In the moral area of whether or not to treat someone as a human being with the dignity and respect a human being deserves as a precious child of God, made in God's image, we as disciples of Jesus Christ cannot pick and choose.

Jesus never treated anyone as a problem to be done away with, turned away, ignored or destroyed. Nor should we. Whether that life is in the womb, at the border of our country, in the Communion line in church, or living in our neighborhood or in our own house.

This is a difficult teaching for us to follow. If we were all honest, we would admit that none of us does this perfectly. We are all at times inconsistent. Some of us in one breath say, "Protect the unborn," and then in the next breath call for turning away Afghanistan refugees. And some of us do just the opposite: call for the protection of migrants but say it is okay to choose to end a life in the womb.

The only thing that is consistent in life is God's immeasurable love. God's love for us should cast out all our fear, fear of the unknown, fear of change, fear of the stranger. Once we are not afraid, we can find new ways to care for each other and build a society, a Church, a world where all people can feel not only safe, but welcomed and embraced as the children of God they are.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

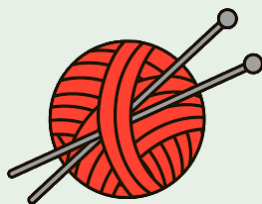
PRAYER SHAWL MINISTRY
