VOCATION

(By Frederick Buechner)

It comes from the Latin *vocare*, to call, and means the work a [person] is called to by God.

There are all different kinds of voices calling you to all different kinds of work, and the problem is to find out which is the voice of God rather than of society, say, of the super-ego, or self-interest.

By and large, a good rule for finding out is this. The kind of work God usually calls you to is the kind of work
(a) that you need most to do and
(b) that the world most needs to have done.

PRAYER FOR VOCATIONS

Lord Jesus, Son of the Eternal Father and Mary Immaculate, give to your people the generosity necessary to follow Your call and the courage required to overcome all obstacles to their vocation.

Give to parents that faith, love and spirit of sacrifice which will inspire them to offer their children to God's service and to rejoice whenever one of their children is called to the priesthood or religious life.

May your example and that of Your Blessed Mother and Saint Joseph encourage both young people and parents and let Your grace sustain them.

WHERE DO CATHOLIC PRIESTS COME FROM?

They are not hatched. They are not manufactured on an assembly line. They do not fall from heaven.

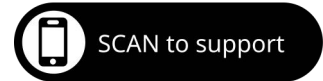

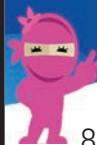
