LAST SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

HERE'S WHAT IS DIFFERENT

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

It is ironic that we call Jesus Christ a King when Jesus himself never came out and said it Himself. In this dialogue with Pontius Pilate, the Roman governor of Judea, the official representative of the Roman Emperor, Tiberius Caesar, Jesus is asked by Pilate: "Are you a king?" "You say that I am," Jesus says. And we say it, too.

But Jesus does not.

I propose calling Jesus a King has gotten us into trouble through the years. It has allowed us to think Christ has the attributes of an earthly King ... powerful authority that is backed up by a powerful army. Maybe this is why popes in the past thought it okay to call Christendom to arms, to spill blood to defend the Holy Land.

Jesus wanted no blood spilt to defend Him.

Thinking of Jesus as a King has also, for many people, made Him distant and cold ... as most monarchs have been perceived. In a country that has no monarch, like ours, calling Jesus a King makes Him even more unrelatable. And yet, wasn't the point of Christ's incarnation to be one with us and for us?

I think we call Jesus a King because Jesus himself speaks often of the Kingdom of God. A kingdom needs a king, right? But Jesus tells us His Kingdom is different. It is not of this world. If it were of this world, Jesus says, his followers "would be fighting to keep him from being handed over." But there is no fighting in His Kingdom. There is no violence. His Kingdom is different.

To call Jesus Christ our Lord and King means we are part of His Kingdom. We belong to Him. It means we will listen to His voice, He who is our Truth.

I am not sure if Pilate understood what Jesus was telling him. I am not sure if Jesus' own friends and disciples fully understood. It took some time, that's for sure. I know I don't always fully understand. But if I want to live forever in the Kingdom of Heaven, this I do know: I have to live *today* for the Kingdom of God.

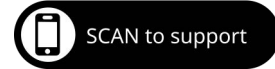
