GOSPEL MARK 12: 38-44

In the course of his teaching Jesus said to the crowds, "Beware of the scribes, who like to go around in long robes and accept greetings in the marketplaces, seats of honor in synagogues, and places of honor at banquets. They devour the houses of widows and, as a pretext recite lengthy prayers. They will receive a very severe condemnation." He sat down opposite the treasury and observed how the crowd put money into the treasury. Many rich people put in large sums. A poor widow also came and put in two small coins worth a few cents. Calling his disciples to himself, he said to them, "Amen, I say to you, this poor widow put in more than all the other contributors to the treasury. For they have all contributed from their surplus wealth, but she, from her poverty, has contributed all she had, her whole livelihood."

FAITH SHARING QUESTIONS

- 1) What is it you do to be charitable to those in need?
- 2) Have you even witnessed someone giving from their need rather than their surplus? Who was that and what did they do?

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

As I mentioned last week in my homily, sometimes we encounter words in Church that we seldom use in other places. Words like "**hallow**," which means "holy, sacred."

Or like: "**behold!**" This word is used when an angel announces important news, or when a person, like Mary, recognizes how God is moving in her life ("Behold, I am the handmaid of the Lord!) or when John the Baptist recognizes the presence of the Messiah ("Behold the Lamb of God!").

That leads me to another word: **Vocation**. Unlike a vacation, which gives you a break from work, **vocation** is about the work God calls a person to do in their life. Vocation is about how you and I use our talents, personality and interests, in response to Christ's invitation to follow Him as a disciple.

Every human being is called by God to love. As baptized Christians, we are also called to follow Jesus Christ, to love as He loves. For some, that calling might lead to service in Church ministry, whether ordained ministry (like the priesthood), or lay ministry (like catechists, lectors, etc), for most others that calling might lead to marriage (let's not forget the Church also describes marriage as a vocation).

As disciples of Christ we are all asked to discern how God is calling us. There's another word used often in church-talk: **discern**. Discernment adds God to the process of making important life decisions. For example: when we are young, we are often asked: "what do you want to be when you grow up?" As we mature, because we are Christians, we let our faith help us answer that question. We take the question to Christ in prayer. We listen to the promptings of the Holy Spirit. We include Gospel values in our decision. Behold! We want not only to live for ourselves, but also to live for Christ! We want to lead not a hollow life, but one that is hallowed! This is discernment.

Discernment is the process of reflecting on and recognizing who I am before God! This is what we see from Mary and John the Baptist.

This week, I ask everyone to strengthen our **Vocation Vocabulary** — our **Vo-Cab**, if you will. Parents especially, can I ask you to speak about vocation at home, to actually use the word, to include God, Jesus & the Church in your discussions with your kids about the important decisions they must make regarding friendship, love, service, schooling, work. We must all learn to see how God's call takes place in our ordinary lives, "through the concrete desires, affections and historical moments" of our lives. Both individual prayer and celebrating the Eucharist with the faith community will help us pay attention to how God is moving in our lives and calling us to become the person we have been created to be. As St. Catherine of Sienna said, "Be who God meant you to be and you will set the world on fire."

VOCATION

(By Frederick Buechner)

It comes from the Latin *vocare*, to call, and means the work a [person] is called to by God.

There are all different kinds of voices calling you to all different kinds of work, and the problem is to find out which is the voice of God rather than of society, say, of the super-ego, or self-interest.

By and large, a good rule for finding out is this. The kind of work God usually calls you to is the kind of work (a) that you need most to do and (b) that the world most needs to have done.

PRAYER FOR VOCATIONS

Lord Jesus, Son of the Eternal Father and Mary Immaculate, give to your people the generosity necessary to follow Your call and the courage required to overcome all obstacles to their vocation.

Give to parents that faith, love and spirit of sacrifice which will inspire them to offer their children to God's service and to rejoice whenever one of their children is called to the priesthood or religious life.

May your example and that of Your Blessed Mother and Saint Joseph encourage both young people and parents and let Your grace sustain them. Amen.

WHERE DO CATHOLIC PRIESTS COME FROM?

They are not hatched. They are not manufactured on an assembly line. They do not fall from heaven. They come from ordinary families and households. They come from Catholic schools and public schools. They come from all walks of life. They could indeed come from our parish here in Marlton, NJ. That someone could be sitting in your pew today. That someone could be you. Or someone you know.

During the next two weekends, along with all the Catholic Churches in our Diocese of Trenton and throughout the United States, we will focus on Vocation Awareness. We will ask you to prayerfully identify and recommend potential candidates "by name" whom you think might have a priestly vocation. Our Diocesan Vocation Team will then follow up directly with those individuals recommended.

CALLED TO ORDAINED PRIESTHOOD

Beginning this weekend, each parish in our Diocese of Trenton is participating in **CALLED BY NAME**, a program of Vocation Awareness. The program offers an opportunity for all of us, first, to pray for vocations; to recognize gifts and potential for leadership and service in members of our parish; and finally, to call forth and encourage these members to share their gifts in the ordained priesthood.

Perhaps you know a man (16 years of age or older) who would, in your opinion, have the qualities to become a priest. Please recommend this person by filling out a **Response Card** found in our church vestibules. Put the card in the Collection Box either this weekend or next weekend, or drop it off or mail it to the Parish Office.

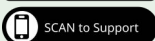

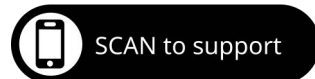

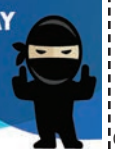
