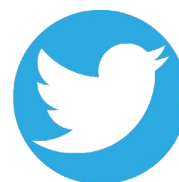

31ST SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME/2021

HALLOW, NOT HOLLOW

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

"Hallow" is not a word we use often in ordinary speech. It is, however, a word many of you say every day of your life. If you pray the "Our Father," you say each time: "Our Father who art in heaven, **hallowed** be Thy name."

Hallow. To make holy.

In old English, then, "All Hallows Day" meant "All Saints Day," The Saints are the holy ones. Every First of November we honor them, the women and men who have lived a life of faithful discipleship, people who have loved God with their whole heart and soul and mind and body, people who have loved others the way Jesus loves us.

Many centuries ago, the night before All Hallows Day began to be called All Hallows Eve ... Halloween ... because in the Church, a big feast always begins the night before.

Halloween began as a celebration of God's victory over death and darkness. It was, in effect, Autumn's Easter! Scary costumes were worn in fun to show we had no fear of witches and goblins or anything affiliated with death and darkness. God's light and love shines far brighter! In Jesus Christ we are saved and protected. There is no power stronger than the love of God in Christ. We have nothing to fear.

I have no problem with dressing up in costume. I certainly have no problem with getting and eating candy. :) But I fear without the context of faith, Halloween becomes a bit hollow, as does any religious holy day without the religious meaning. Christmas without Christ. Easter without the Resurrection. Halloween without the Saints.

Let's teach our children, as they dress up in scary outfits, that nothing can truly frighten a person who walks with Jesus, that God knows who we are underneath the funny masks we wear, that God sees the heart, not the clothes we wear. As they gorge on sugar, let's teach them as Christians we feast on the Bread of Life, the Eucharist. Let's teach them and give them the tools to live as saints, holy people, every day of the year.

Halloween can and should be fun. But it can also be filled with faith. Make it a Hallow, not a hollow, ween!
