Say hello and welcome those sitting around you ... you may be saying hello to someone who is coming to church for the first time ever or after being away for a while. This is a great opportunity for us to evangelize ... which is a fancy way of saying sharing the love and joy of Jesus Christ!

Upon leaving church it would be a great help to us if everyone would look around your pew and clean up like you would when leaving the beach ... this way the church will look nice for those coming to the next Mass.

For those who will be traveling, we wish you our very best for a joyful Christmas. For those of us who will be staying home, let's keep all travelers in our prayers. Remember, Mary and Joseph were "on the road" as well, for that first Christmas.

On behalf of our clergy, Sisters of St. Joseph, and entire staff, we wish everyone a Christmas that brings you a deeper faith in God, a closer walk with Jesus, and a stronger love for your family and friends with a firmer commitment to make this world a safe and peaceful place for everyone!

• We have had a busy few months in Religious Education - in-person classes for our 1st, 2nd, 7th and 8th graders, Special Disciples and RCIA Tweens, virtual classes and home study for our 3rd through 6th graders, and preparing to welcome our RCIA Teens. We are so grateful to our amazing catechists and volunteers for the wonderful work they are doing! Some of our catechists and school teachers attended an 'Art of Catechesis' class in November, which is designed to help those handing on the faith grown in their ministry. We look forward to offering this class again in the spring and will publish that date when it is set; anyone interested in becoming a catechist is welcome to attend!

These faith-based activities are meant to help families build Domestic Church in their homes and help us to prepare our hearts to celebrate the birth of Jesus. Some of our activity options include those based on the corporal and spiritual works of mercy, the blessing of the Christmas tree or Nativity at home, celebrating St. Nicholas Day (the Catholic way!), attending our upcoming Christmas Carol Festival or Simbang Gabi Mass, and more. These activities are for all families, and we welcome you to read more about them at www.stjoans.org/religious-education.

• As we prepare for Christmas during this holy season of Advent, we are grateful for the support of our volunteers, families and the St. Joan's Parish community as we accompany our children in their own journey of faith. God bless and we look forward to continuing to grow in faith together in 2022!
