## GOSPEL LUKE 3: 10-18

The crowds asked John the Baptist, "What should we do?" He said to them in reply, "Whoever has two cloaks should share with the person who has none. And whoever has food should do likewise." Even tax collectors came to be baptized and they said to him, "Teacher, what should we do?" He answered them, "Stop collecting more than what is prescribed." Soldiers also asked him, "And what is it that we should do?" He told them, "Do not practice extortion, do not falsely accuse anyone, and be satisfied with your wages." Now the people were filled with expectation, and all were asking in their hearts whether John might be the Christ. John answered them all, saying, "I am baptizing you with water, but one mightier than I is coming. I am not worthy to loosen the thongs of his sandals. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire. His winnowing fan is in his hand to clear his threshing floor and to gather the wheat into his barn, but the chaff he will burn with unquenchable fire." Exhorting them in many other ways, he preached good news to the people.

## DON'T DO NOTHING

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

Not sure how grammatically correct it is, but when I hear today's Gospel I hear the Baptist crying out, "Don't do nothing! In other words ... do something. Doing nothing in the presence of God is not an option.

Crowds of people are asking John: "What should we do?" He tells them bluntly and honestly. John has never minded rattling a few cages which is how he ended up getting thrown in one.

God is real. God is here. God loves you. Do you believe this? If you do, then you have to do something; you have to respond. It has to impact upon your life in some way. It has to make a difference. Quite frankly, not believing in God is a better response, maybe even a more honest one, than believing in God and doing nothing about it!

The God we believe in (the one revealed to us in Christ Jesus) wants to be involved in our life and wants us to be involved in God's life. In baptism, we become part of Christ's mystical body. Christianity is therefore a participation sport (religion, faith). And it is a team sport (religion, faith) because we believe God's Spirit is within us. God's Spirit unites us and makes us one.

Each new day is an invitation to meet God, to bring Christ's joy and peace everywhere we go. Don't do nothing.

Each conversation is a chance to learn and grow.  
Don't do nothing.

Each Mass we attend is a chance to lift up our hearts to God, to unite ourselves with one another and give ourselves as a gift to God. Don't do nothing.

Do something! We were made for this: to participate in the life of the Trinity, in the outpouring of God's life and love. It's in our DNA. As I said during Mass on the Feast of the Immaculate Conception, ignoring this is like walking away from your Christmas gifts, leaving them wrapped up under the tree. That would be crazy. Let's not be crazy. Let's ...

Participate!

## RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

- We have had a busy few months in Religious Education - in-person classes for our 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> graders, Special Disciples and RCIA Tweens, virtual classes and home study for our 3<sup>rd</sup> through 6<sup>th</sup> graders, and preparing to welcome our RCIA Teens - and we are so grateful to our amazing catechists and volunteers for the wonderful work they are doing! Some of our catechists and school teachers attended an 'Art of Catechesis' class in November, which is designed to help those handing on the faith grown in their ministry.
