## GOSPEL LUKE 3: 1-6

In the fifteenth year of the reign of Tiberius Caesar, when Pontius Pilate was governor of Judea, and Herod was tetrarch of Galilee, and his brother Philip tetrarch of the region of Ituraea and Trachonitis, and Lysanias was tetrarch of Abilene, during the high priesthood of Annas and Caiaphas, the word of God came to John the son of Zechariah in the desert. John went throughout the whole region of the Jordan, proclaiming a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins, as it is written in the book of the words of the prophet Isaiah: *A voice of one crying out in the desert: "Prepare the way of the Lord, make straight his paths. ## A VOICE. HEAR IT?

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

A voice cries out in the wilderness. In the desert. It is John the Baptist. "Prepare the way of the Lord," he shouts. Can you hear it? Or is he just shouting into the wind? Is it only scorpions and cactus that can hear?

To hear, really hear, this message, we might have to go into the desert. Into an empty place. In a place of stillness and quiet. Into a place that is only horizon and sky. Into a place that is not so crowded.

This is why Advent is such a counter-cultural season. The world is very noisy right now. Not just with bad, ugly noise (though there is plenty of that, surely!), but also the noise that comes with busyness and rushing about and getting things done. This is a busy time of year. There is so much to do, to get ready for THE day.

But Advent reminds us of a Christmas that will last forever. Advent reminds us that, in reality, all of life is advent ... a preparing for the coming of Christ. Advent reminds us that all of life is about finding Christ now, today, here. To do that, sometimes you have to go into a quiet space. We don't have to leave town to find it. But it might mean a few minutes a day without our phone or computer. Just a few. Just long enough to hear a prophet in the desert shouting to us.

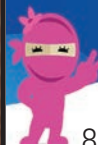
