# **GOSPEL JOHN 2: 1-11**

There was a wedding at Cana in Galilee, and the mother of Jesus was there. Jesus and his disciples were also invited to the wedding. When the wine ran short, the mother of Jesus said to him, "They have no wine." And Jesus said to her, "Woman, how does your concern affect me? My hour has not yet come." His mother said to the servers, "Do whatever he tells you." Now there were six stone water jars there for Jewish ceremonial washings, each holding twenty to thirty gallons. Jesus told them, "Fill the jars with water." So they filled them to the brim. Then he told them, "Draw some out now and take it to the headwaiter." So they took it. And when the headwaiter tasted the water that had become wine, without knowing where it came from — although the servers who had drawn the water knew -, the headwaiter called the bridegroom and said to him, "Everyone serves good wine first, and then when people have drunk freely, an inferior one; but you have kept the good wine until now." Jesus did this as the beginning of his signs at Cana in Galilee and so revealed his glory, and his disciples began to believe in him.

# AN ORDINARY WEDDING

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

This year, Ordinary Time — the Church's biggest liturgical season that fills in the calendar between the biggest Solemnities of Christmas and Easter and their respective preparatory seasons of Advent and Lent — begins with a wedding. What could be more "ordinary" than that?

Weddings are "ordinary" in the sense that they are part of real life. To the bride and the groom, of course, there is nothing ordinary about it. It is the best day of their life. It is the day they promise to love each other forever ... on good days, bad days, and the ordinary days in between. So, how wonderfully perfect is it that Jesus goes to a wedding?

An event that celebrate the deepest of love, a love that truly models the way God loves us. Of course, Jesus would be there! (Check out John 2:1-11.) It's an amazing miracle ... but when you think about, it's exactly what Jesus is going to do all through His ministry in every encounter.

When joy runs out; Jesus makes more.

When peace runs out; Jesus makes more.

When love goes dry, when hope grows dim, when mercy wears thin ... Jesus makes more and more and more.

When on any ordinary day in January or February or June or July, when we think we might have hit the bottom of the barrel, run out of steam, or worn out the last shred of our patience ... all we have to say to Jesus is, "I have no more." And like we saw at that wedding feast in a town called Cana, Jesus is there, with us, giving us more than we ever imagined possible.

- The Church borrowed \$1,100,000 in February of 2012 for the Church refurbishing project. The loan balance at June 30, 2021 is approximately \$415,000.

# WEDDINGS AT ST. JOAN OF ARC

We hope you will consider celebrating your marriage in the Catholic Church. Below we hope you find some helpful information:

- 1. Catholics consider marriage a Sacrament. It is the highest honor we can name it. Like Baptism or the Eucharist and all the Sacraments, marriage is an outward sign of the presence of Christ in our world. United in Christ, a husband and wife are called to love each other the way God loves us!
- 2. Catholics can marry non-Catholics in the Catholic Church. They can even marry non-Catholics in the non-Catholic's place of worship and have it recognized as a Sacrament.
- 3. Those who have been previously married and are divorced can marry in the Catholic Church, although an annulment will be necessary. Before you say "it sounds too difficult," please call us. We'd like to talk to you about this.
- 4. Couples marrying in the Catholic Church are asked to participate in a pre-marital preparation program that involves meeting with a priest/deacon and also joining in a workshop with married couples (one example of this is called Pre-Cana). This program isn't meant to put obstacles in your way, but to help you prepare for the wedding celebration and also on the meaning of making a Sacramental marriage.
- 5. We know "destination" weddings, or "one-venue" weddings, are very popular nowadays. If planning one, please call us early so we can discuss with you the options available to you to bless your marriage in the Church.
- 6. Weddings in the Catholic Church do not have to be "big" or expensive. We can do a simple, yet beautiful, Nuptial Mass or Nuptial Ceremony. A Nuptial Mass includes receiving the Eucharist; a Nuptial Ceremony does not.
- 7. Here at St. Joan of Arc, we celebrate weddings on Fridays and Saturdays, but also on other days of the week.


