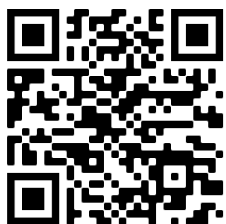

GOSPEL LUKE 1: 1-4; 4: 14-21

Since many have undertaken to compile a narrative of the events that have been fulfilled among us, just as those who were eyewitnesses from the beginning and ministers of the word have handed them down to us, I too have decided, after investigating everything accurately anew, to write it down in an orderly sequence for you, most excellent Theophilus, so that you may realize the certainty of the teachings you have received. Jesus returned to Galilee in the power of the Spirit, and news of him spread throughout the whole region. He taught in their synagogues and was praised by all. He came to Nazareth, where he had grown up, and went according to his custom into the synagogue on the sabbath day. He stood up to read and was handed a scroll of the prophet Isaiah. He unrolled the scroll and found the passage where it was written: The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he has anointed me to bring glad tidings to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim liberty to captives and recovery of sight to the blind, to let the oppressed go free, and to proclaim a year acceptable to the Lord. Rolling up the scroll, he handed it back to the attendant and sat down, and the eyes of all in the synagogue looked intently at him. He said to them, "Today this Scripture passage is fulfilled in your hearing."

BIBLE-IN-HAND

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

We take the Bible for granted because most of us own our own personal copy of it. Or, now, we can hold the entire Bible in the palm of our hand, on our phone. One click of an app and all the books of the Old and New Testaments are open to us.

But for the first 1400 years or so of Christianity, the only people who would have had access to a copy of the Bible would be those affiliated with monasteries and universities, the clergy, and those rich enough to afford it. The Bible was not readily available to the ordinary Christian precisely because making a copy of God's Word during this time was no easy chore. For the most part, Bibles were copied, and often beautifully illustrated, by Monks, by hand.

The printing press changed all that. And through the insistence of the leaders of the Protestant Reformation, more and more people began to read the Bible on their own time in their own home.

One would hope that with greater access to the printed Word of God, more people than ever are reading it, studying it, praying it.

In the 20th century, the Catholic Church experienced its own "Bible Revival." The Second Vatican Council encouraged all Catholics to read the Word of God as part of our life of discipleship. Furthermore, the Council directed that the treasures of the Scriptures be opened even more so that at every Sunday Mass Eucharist we proclaim and listen to three passages from the Bible and also a Psalm.

Lay people proclaiming the Scriptures at Mass is a relatively recent development. And before 1965, you would not have seen a woman standing at the ambo (pulpit) proclaiming the Word of God. Today, in our parish, the majority of our Lectors are women.

Let's not take the Bible for granted. Nor should we take for granted who can read it or proclaim it. Today is Word of God Sunday. Let's each renew our relationship with the Scriptures and make a greater attempt this year to spend more time in its pages, whether those pages be on paper or a screen.

“SYNOD”: To Journey Together

Sharing Your Own Experience

Pope Francis has given all the Catholic faithful an opportunity to take part in the preparation for the 2023 Synod of Bishops in our own diocese and parishes. You might wonder why the experience of individual people is so important. Our stories illustrate how we live our faith in the concrete everyday of our lives. Listening to each other’s stories helps us relate to one another, to empathize, to recognize our common hopes and the faith that sustains us. If we are willing to ponder these stories and consider them in the light of our call to be Church, then we might be able to hear what the Spirit is saying to the Church in our time.

Listening to Everyone

The author James Joyce is known for describing the Catholic Church as “here comes everybody!” We hope the next two months will be a time for great listening – listening among those who are active within the parish, and those who are no longer engaged; those who attend Mass regularly and those who don’t feel welcome. Our stories are sacred. They demonstrate how God works in each of our lives to bring about His plan. This Synod process invites us to stand in the shoes of another and learn from the story that they share.

Please plan to participate in one of our parish’s Synod Listening Sessions and invite others you know to tell their stories. Next **Sunday, January 30th in the bulletin and on our website (www.stjoans.org), we will have the dates and times of an initial round of Listening Sessions. We will happily schedule more, if more are needed. If you are already a member of a parish ministry that has Small Group Faith Sharing (i.e., TMIY, Women of Faith, etc.) you will hear of a way to participate in a Synod Listening Session through that ministry.**

MAKE FRIENDS WITH THE BIBLE

*Then they said to each other,

SACRED SCRIPTURE: DAILY & SUNDAY

It’s a good practice to read the Bible everyday — but we should all at the very least make an effort to have already read the Gospel before attending Sunday Mass. There are many sources — in print and online — that contain the Bible readings proclaimed each Sunday and also every day of the week. These resources also offer other helpful reflections and articles).

Here’s a list of just some:

In Print:

There are also many Catholic apps which feature the Bible. In your App store, search for “Catholic Bible” and you will find resources such as

- **LAUDATE, CATHOLIC DAILY READINGS, THE WORD AMONG US, YOUCAT** (for young people).

WHAT KIND OF BIBLE SHOULD I GET?

The Scriptures that are read each Sunday in every Catholic Church in the United States are taken from the **NEW AMERICAN BIBLE, revised edition**. You can purchase one (in various shapes and sizes) from your favorite brick and mortar bookstore or online. Locally, try



Abbot Church Supply in Cherry Hill; online, you can go to **autom.com**. (It’s a good bet Amazon has them, as well.)

READING THE BIBLE

It’s a good practice to read the Bible within the context of prayer. Before reading a passage, pray: “Come, Holy Spirit, open my ears and my mind and my heart to receive God’s Word. Amen.”

When possible, read the passage twice, once aloud.

Don’t immediately look for the passage’s meaning. “I don’t understand what it means” is a common complaint and then obstacle to reading further. Instead, after reading a passage, make a note of the words and phrases and images that get your attention. Note what feelings within you are stirred by the passage. This is how the Holy Spirit is speaking to you through this passage. Then ask: “what is this passage saying to me right now, given all that is going on in my life?”

Many times the passage will comfort us, or bring clarity or peace, or even challenge our thinking or attitude.
