GOSPEL LUKE 4: 21-30

Jesus began speaking in the synagogue, saying: "Today this Scripture passage is fulfilled in your hearing." And all spoke highly of him and were amazed at the gracious words that came from his mouth. They also asked, "Isn't this the son of Joseph?" He said to them, "Surely you will quote me this proverb, 'Physician, cure yourself,' and say, 'Do here in your native place the things that we heard were done in Capernaum." And he said, "Amen, I say to you, no prophet is accepted in his own native place. Indeed, I tell you, there were many widows in Israel in the days of Elijah when the sky was closed for three and a half years and a severe famine spread over the entire land. It was to none of these that Elijah was sent, but only to a widow in Zarephath in the land of Sidon. Again, there were many lepers in Israel during the time of Elisha the prophet; yet not one of them was cleansed, but only Naaman the Syrian." When the people in the synagogue heard this, they were all filled with fury. They rose up, drove him out of the town, and led him to the brow of the hill on which their town had been built, to hurl him down headlong. But Jesus passed through the midst of them and went away.

SHOES OF LOVE

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

When was the last time you were at a wedding? Chances are that's also the last time you heard the beautiful passage on love by St. Paul. If you were in Church this weekend, you heard it proclaimed as our second reading.

Love is patient. Love is kind.

When it comes to love, we might say,

"Easier said than done." Easier to talk about being patient than being patient. Easier to talk about forgiveness than actually forgiving someone. Easier to talk about understanding and empathy than it is to walk in someone else's shoes.

So, this is what is amazing and different about the God we believe in. The God we believe in isn't simply "all talk." The God we believe in puts His money where Her mouth is. The God we pray to doesn't keep a safe distance. Our God, the God of Abraham and Sarah, the God of Isaiah and John the Baptist, the God of Mary and Joseph, the God of Jesus Christ enters fully into our world, our skin, our human situations. Jesus Christ gets into our shoes, from birth to death.

Our God is patient and kind. Our God does forgive, over and over and over. Our God is understanding and compassionate. Our God does go the extra mile and does put others first. Our God gives up control and becomes vulnerable and gives all. Our God doesn't show point the way to love, our God is love!

So, the night before He is killed, when Jesus gives us a new commandment "to love one another as He loves us," He shows us how to do this. And, He does not leave us alone to work out the details. He fills us with His Spirit so that we can love in a completely new way. Jesus' way. God's way. The only way that can truly save us forever!

The goal of synod listening is not data gathering or problem-solving. It is not focused on debating the controversial issues of the day or complaining. It is primarily a spiritual exercise, rooted in prayer. Everyone has something to share. Everyone has something to learn. Listening to each other and to the Holy Spirit can change our attitudes, illuminate our understandings, and guide our behavior. It can change us!

Pope Francis hopes this listening will "plant dreams, draw forth prophecies and visions, allow hope to flourish, inspire trust, bind up wounds, weave together relationships." From it will come a way of being Church that remains faithful to the truths of our faith but allows us to pastorally respond anew to the needs of the present time.
