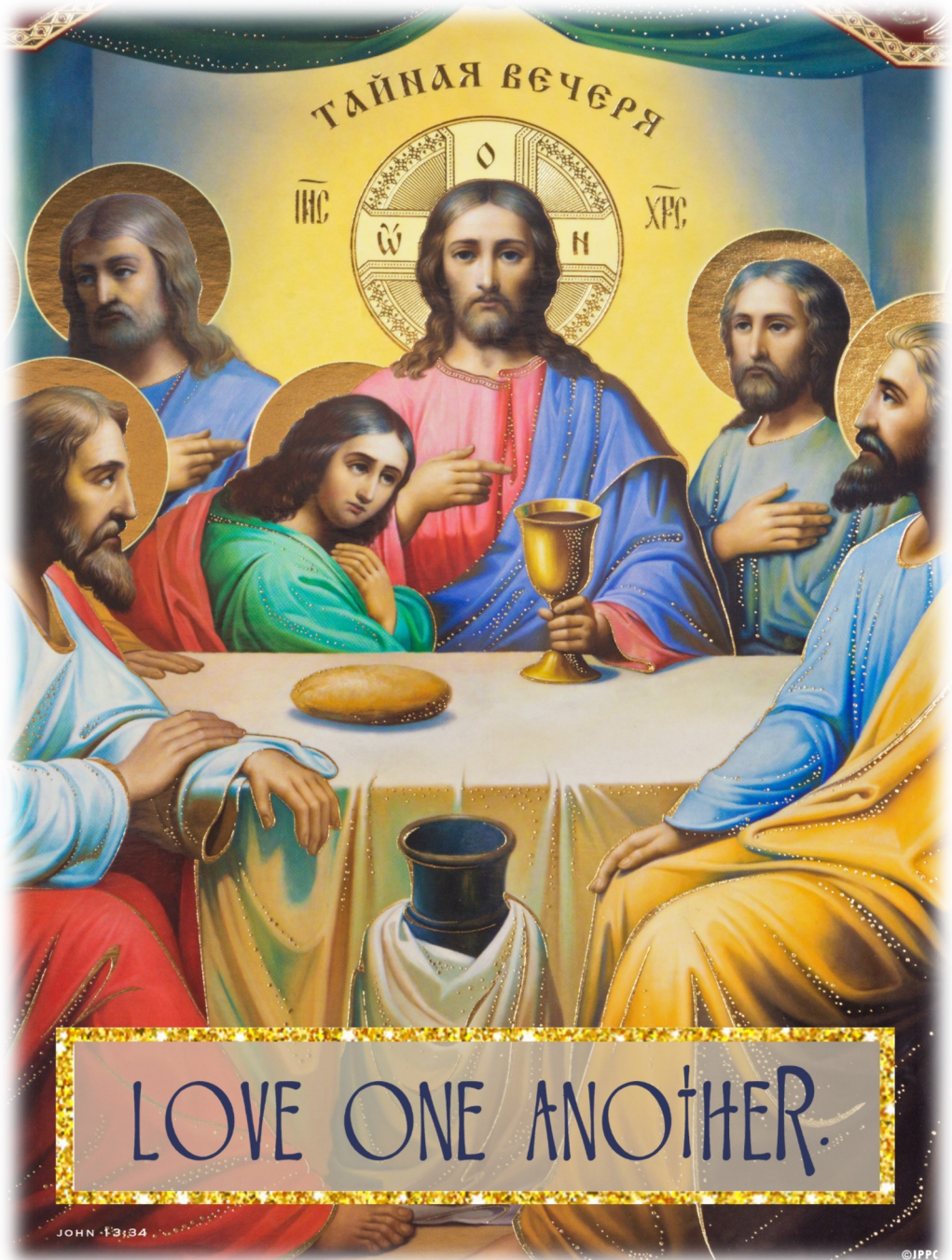

## COMMUNION: INSIDE & OUTSIDE OF CHURCH

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

This year 181 Second Graders in our parish elementary School and Religious Education Program celebrated their First Eucharist! Congratulations to them and to their parents and families. I am so grateful to their parents for fulfilling the promise they made at their child's baptism, the promise to share their faith in Jesus Christ and to raise their daughter or son in the Christian faith, in the Catholic Church.

I am also very grateful to the many teachers and catechists, along with their faithful aides, who prepared our children so well to receive this beautiful Sacrament, Holy Communion, the Body of Christ! They, like the parents of these children, are committed to sharing our faith in Jesus Christ with our young people. Thank you to Mrs. Jessica Donohue and Mrs. Debbie Galamb in our Religious Education Office for doing a great job in coordinating the program, as well as the liturgies themselves.

All during this Easter Season we have been hearing in our first Scripture reading each Sunday how the early Church grew and flourished in its beginning years. Those first generations of Christians underwent many a hardship to bring the Good News to people who had never heard of nor encountered Jesus the Christ! Indeed, they even expected hardships and sacrifices, as we hear in today's passage from the Acts of the Apostles.

The first Christians were building something completely new, something perhaps never tried before. They were building a new kind of community, a community based on and dedicated to loving each other the way Jesus loved them. As Monika Hellwig, a noted Catholic theologian of the 20<sup>th</sup> Century said, these early Christians understood that "to love as Christ did is to subordinate one's own life and welfare to the common good of the community as a whole."

That community still lives today. You and I, as well as the 181 boys and girls who recently received their First Holy Communion, are part of that community. Our love for one another should be no less real, no less radical, than the first generation of believers in Jesus Christ who truly changed the world they lived in. In this day and age, as we witness the fracturing of community on so many levels, perhaps the Church that can show the world how loving and caring for one another, how sacrificing for the common good, is truly possible.

It is up to us.

Easter isn't over!

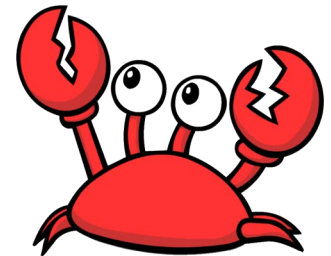

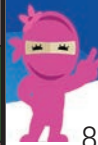
