Dear Parishioners and Friends,

I don't think I have (knowingly) done this in my 15 years of writing bulletin letters here at St. Joan of Arc, but this past week I stumbled upon a letter I wrote in our parish bulletin for Pentecost 10 years ago and I have decided to reprint it word for word below. I guess it is true that the more things change, the more they stay the same. But let's remember: keeping things the same is definitely NOT what the Holy Spirit it all about!

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

Come, Holy Spirit, renew the face of the earth! This is our special prayer for Pentecost. There is much to renew, that's for sure. You don't need a litany of woes from me — and today's Feast doesn't call for negativism or pessimism. It calls for optimistic, positive, hopeful action and change.

In the first Pentecost, the Holy Spirit transformed a frightened band of disciples into a courageous community willing to risk everything on behalf of Jesus Christ and His Kingdom of Love. May this Pentecost see another such transformation.

Veni Sancte Spiritus! Come Holy Spirit! Fill our hearts with the fire of Your love. Renew the face of the earth!

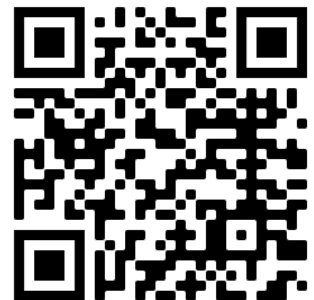
