GOSPEL

LUKE 11:1-13

Jesus was praying in a certain place, and when he had finished, one of his disciples said to him, "Lord, teach us to pray just as John taught his disciples." He said to them, "When you pray, say:

Father, hallowed be your name,
your kingdom come.
Give us each day our daily bread
and forgive us our sins
for we ourselves forgive everyone in debt to us,
and do not subject us to the final test."

And he said to them, "Suppose one of you has a friend to whom he goes at midnight and says, 'Friend, lend me three loaves of bread, for a friend of mine has arrived at my house from a journey and I have nothing to offer him,' and he says in reply from within, 'Do not bother me; the door has already been locked and my children and I are already in bed. I cannot get up to give you anything.' I tell you, if he does not get up to give the visitor the loaves because of their friendship, he will get up to give him whatever he needs because of his persistence.

"And I tell you, ask and you will receive; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you. For everyone who asks, receives; and the one who seeks, finds; and to the one who knocks, the door will be opened. What father among you would hand his son a snake when he asks for a fish? Or hand him a scorpion when he asks for an egg? If you then, who are wicked, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will the Father in heaven give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him?"

MARY AND THE EUCHARIST

the 5th in a Weekly Series on the Eucharist

I believe it is fitting to end this series on one of the most precious aspects of our Faith, the Eucharist, with another area of doctrine so closely associated with Catholicism: our devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary. What does Our Lady have to do with the Eucharist? To see, we must first recall the concept of sacramentality we discussed all the way at the beginning of this series. God mediates his grace to us through parts of His creation, such that they become visible signs of His invisible grace. There is no greater example of this than the Eucharist, where the very substance of God becomes truly present under the appearance of bread and wine. God comes to us, "in the flesh" as it were. But God is pure Spirit. It is not as if He bore flesh from all eternity. Rather, the Son, the second person of the Holy Trinity, assumed flesh at a particular moment and place. The Son, the Divine Word, was made flesh upon Mary's "fiat," that is, her acceptance of God's will for her to bear His only Son. Thus, that flesh which is the true food for us to eat is given to us through the Blessed Virgin Mary. Without the Incarnation, there is no Eucharist. So, the importance of Mary to the Eucharistic must not be forgotten, as it was the Blessed Mother who became the vessel of the Incarnation. Her womb became the first Tabernacle, one Holy and Immaculate, bearing the Lord so that one day we might all receive him in the sacrament of the altar.

That she is immaculate, and holy provides us with another insight into the Eucharist. Not only was Mary instrumental in giving us the Eucharist by bearing God in the flesh, she also gives us the perfect example of the devotion we ought to have towards the Eucharist. Who loved her Son more than she? Who was more willing to accept the Lord's will with such humility and joy? When we approach the holy table to receive the Lord, let us remember her devotion. In our human weakness, it can be so easy to be distracted or absent. We can, however, always pray to become more devote, more in love with Christ; we can pray for a love and devotion as strong as Mary's. Indeed, we can pray for Our Lady's intercession, that by her prayers as well as our own, we may love her Son even as she loved him, totally, completely, and until the very end.

One manifestation of that love was a joyful thanksgiving. Let the words of Mary always be in our hearts, "My soul proclaims the greatness of the Lord, my spirit rejoices in God my savior." We should indeed rejoice in thanksgiving for the gift of Jesus just as Mary did, and indeed that is the very meaning of the word Eucharist in Greek, thanksgiving. So, to end here, I would like to offer my own thanksgiving to you all, and to God for having brought me to you. As we have shared in the Eucharistic food together over these six weeks, you, the people of St. Joan's, have showed me a loving welcome and generosity that I cannot describe. It has been my privilege to be with you all this short time. I will forever be grateful for your parish community, and you will be in my prayers. While it pains me to leave, I take great comfort that we remain one in the body of Christ. May God, through the intercession of Our Lady, bless you all.

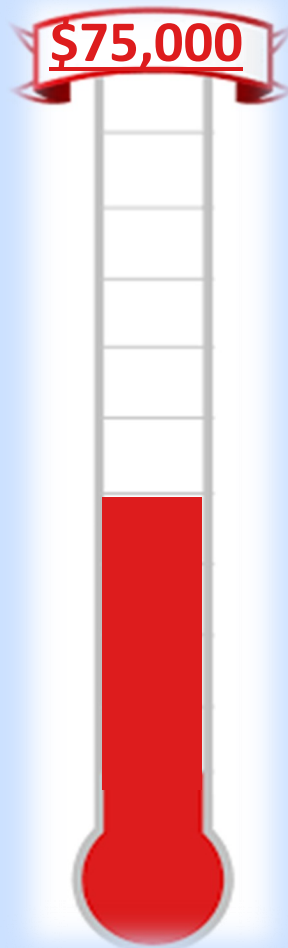

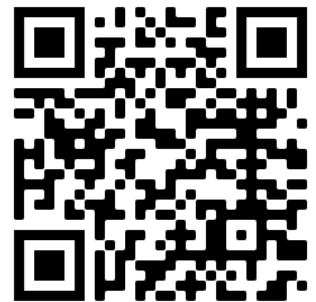
