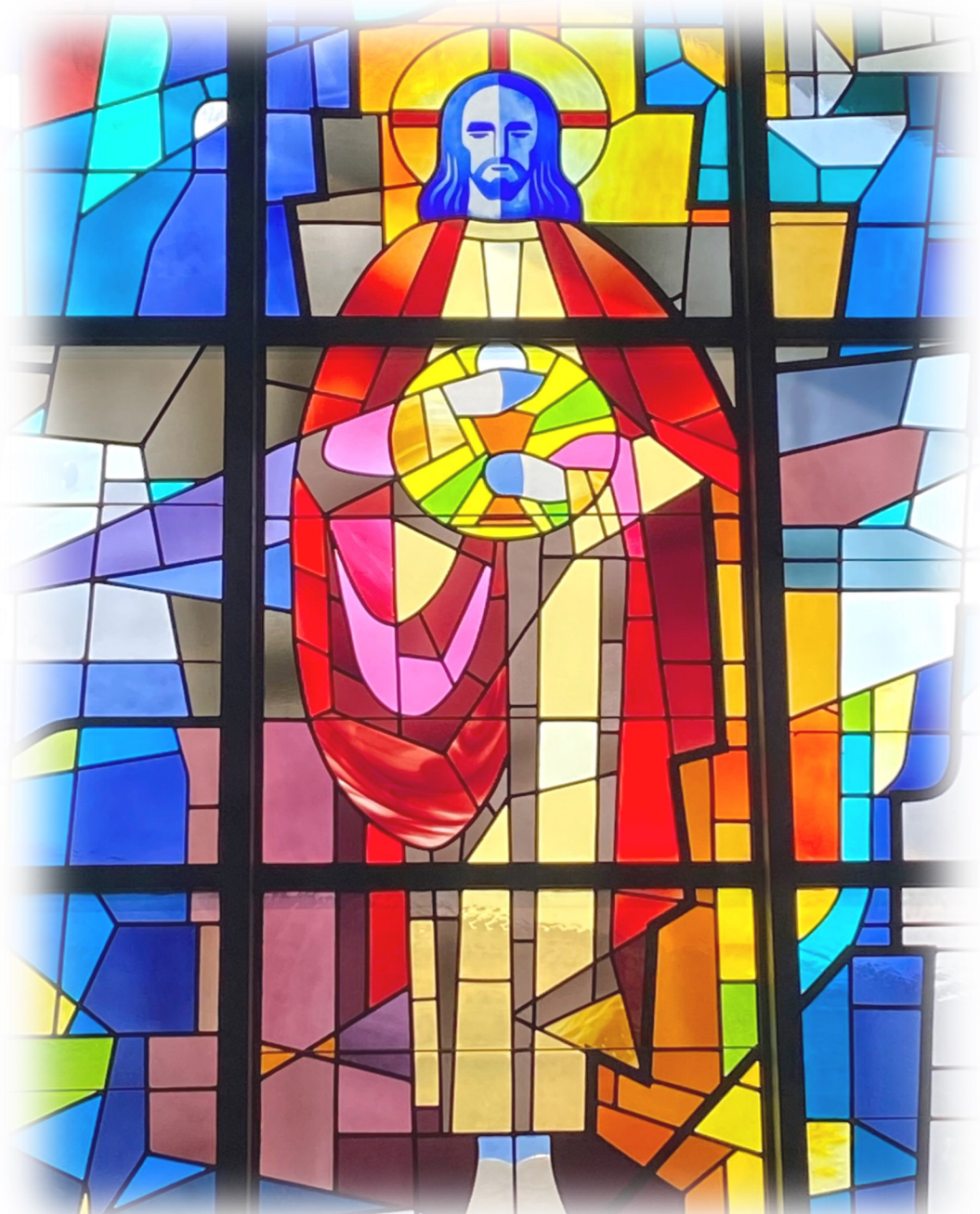

GOSPEL

LUKE 12:32-48

Jesus said to his disciples: "Do not be afraid any longer, little flock, for your Father is pleased to give you the kingdom. Sell your belongings and give alms. Provide money bags for yourselves that do not wear out, an inexhaustible treasure in heaven that no thief can reach nor moth destroy. For where your treasure is, there also will your heart be. "Gird your loins and light your lamps and be like servants who await their master's return from a wedding, ready to open immediately when he comes and knocks. Blessed are those servants whom the master finds vigilant on his arrival. Amen, I say to you, he will gird himself, have them recline at table, and proceed to wait on them. And should he come in the second or third watch and find them prepared in this way, blessed are those servants. Be sure of this: if the master of the house had known the hour when the thief was coming, he would not have let his house be broken into. You also must be prepared, for at an hour you do not expect, the Son of Man will come." Then Peter said, "Lord, is this parable meant for us or for everyone?" And the Lord replied, "Who, then, is the faithful and prudent steward whom the master will put in charge of his servants to distribute the food allowance at the proper time? Blessed is that servant whom his master on arrival finds doing so. Truly, I say to you, the master will put the servant in charge of all his property. But if that servant says to himself, 'My master is delayed in coming,' and begins to beat the menservants and the maidservants, to eat and drink and get drunk, then that servant's master will come on an unexpected day and at an unknown hour and will punish the servant severely and assign him a place with the unfaithful. That servant who knew his master's will but did not make preparations nor act in accord with his will shall be beaten severely; and the servant who was ignorant of his master's will but acted in a way deserving of a severe beating shall be beaten only lightly. Much will be required of the person entrusted with much, and still more will be demanded of the person entrusted with more."

Augustinians of the Assumption - The Assumptionists
 "Our very reason for being, as Assumptionists, is to be found in our motto: Thy Kingdom Come" From the very beginning, the Assumptionists have been engaged in a wide variety of apostolic works. All that advances the coming of the Reign of God has always been deemed worthy of our apostolic energy. It's a preference for poor, in response to the Gospel and to the Church calling us today to be on their side. For us too it's a consequence of our own vow to live as poor men. Some will dedicate themselves full-time to this work: with marginalized people of every kind, in hospitals and in prisons, "worker priests" or volunteers in different organizations... But all of us try to live in union with the poor, because "the poor will always be with us", because the poor are too often neglected even within the Church. This is a bias that the Assumption encourages. Our Province of North America and the Philippines is specifically responsible for the missions in East Africa (Kenya and Tanzania), Mexico and the Philippines. We provide personnel and financial assistance that is indispensable in order to maintain our charitable works (schools and nurseries) and formation programs for both laity and clergy in these countries. Many of our apostolates in these countries specifically work to better the living conditions of the impoverished brothers and sisters we live with and minister to. In the Philippines, we sponsor education and aid programs for underprivileged villages both in the Manilla area and in other mission centers. Our newly founded parish in Orizaba, Veracruz Mexico ministers to an underserved indigenous community. Fr Barry Bercier, A.A., will be here at SJA on the weekend of August 13/14. He will speak at all Masses about the missionary work of the Assumptionist. We will take a special 2nd collection to help their ministry.

WEEKLY REFLECTION ON THE EUCHARIST

Once, during a conversation, a woman told Dorothy Day, the founder of the Catholic Worker, that she, the woman, no longer sees the point of going to daily Mass. Dorothy Day replied: “We go eat of this fruit of the tree of life because Jesus told us to ... He took upon himself our humanity that we might share in his divinity. We are nourished by his flesh that we may grow to be other Christs. I believe this literally, just as I believe the child is nourished by the milk from his mother’s breast.” (From the Duty of Delight: The Diaries of Dorothy Day, p. 483). In our Christmas Day Mass, in the collect, we pray: “O God, who wonderfully created the dignity of human nature and still more wonderfully restored it, grant that we may share in the divinity of Christ, who humbled himself to share in our humanity.” These are the words spoken at every Mass as a small amount of water is poured into the wine in the chalice.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

While the summer tends to be a more quiet time in the Religious Education Office, we were happy to be able to bring back our Summer Program this year, which meant that our campus was joyfully busy between June 27 and July 8! About 130 students in grades 1st through 8th joined us this year, and we spent our two weeks exploring our faith in some wonderful ways. We were blessed to be able to attend Mass each day and were grateful to those who regularly attend daily Mass for welcoming us so kindly! Our students loved learning about the Mass through the great teaching Masses offered by Msgr. Rich and Fr. JM. Our children also got to learn more about our church through church tours with Father JM and our visiting seminarian, Tomás Villacis, who also gave some great talks on vocations to our 3rd through 5th and 6th through 8th graders. We also learned some new hymns, thanks to our SJA music teacher, Mr. Peiffer, and by the end of the two weeks, our children were singing with the angels and reminding us that when we sing to God, we are truly praying twice! 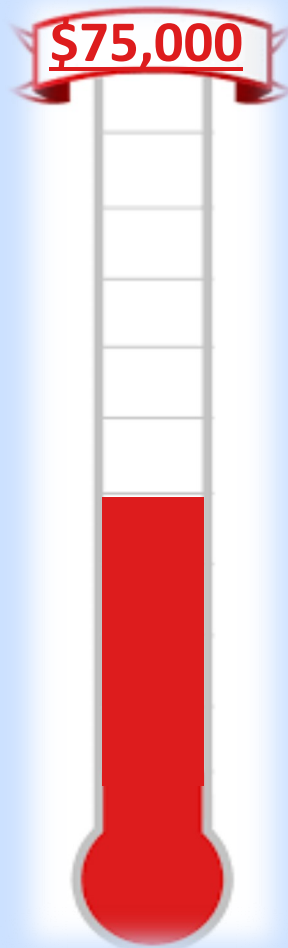
