## Vatican II

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

Last Tuesday we celebrated the 60<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the opening of the Second Vatican Council.

When lay people bring Holy Communion to the sick, it is because of that Council. When parishioners gather around the table for a Parish Pastoral Council or Finance Meeting, it is because of the Second Vatican Council. When a woman goes into the sanctuary to the ambo to read the Word of God, or a young girl carries the Cross down the aisle as an altar server, that is because of Vatican II. When the congregation on Sunday heartfully prays together the Lord's Prayer in their language, that is because of Vatican II. Married men preach the Gospel because of Vatican II. Because of that Council, hundreds of adults right here in our own parish have gone through a life-changing process called the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA). Because of that Council, Catholics pray together with our Protestant sisters and brothers. Because of that Council, Bishops from around the world gather regularly to give advice to the Pope in what we all now know as a Synod. Because of that Council we have a deeper appreciation of our Baptism, of our unity as the Body of Christ, of our co-responsibility in building the Kingdom of God. Because of that Council we understood better that the Church is not a building and not just the hierarchy; the Church is the People of God.

The Second Vatican Council lasted from 1962-65. Did things go smoothly in the years after as its documents were implemented? No. Vatican II occurred during a tumultuous time in the whole world. Were mistakes made in the implementation? Probably. Many will have you believe Vatican II ruined the Church. But please remember: none of the things I mentioned in the paragraph above occurred before that Council. Many will lead you to believe that following the Council everyone stopped going to Church. Not true. I remember packed Churches well into the 1990s (our own parish had to be split because there were so many people going to Mass!). There was an energy and enthusiasm in the Church as new ministries opened up, as people's faith and prayer lives became enlivened, as new spiritual movements sprung up.

My friends, the Holy Spirit is still moving and active. We have had to contend with other tumultuous events, including a culture that no longer assumes there is a God. This is not the time to close up shop. This is a time to proclaim with even more joy and more energy than ever that Jesus Christ is alive! That faith is important and means something! That the love of God can change minds and hearts and lives and even the world for the better!

Please keep praying for the most recent Synod during which over 700,000 Catholics in the United States were involved in sharing their experience of Church and listening to each other. That never happened before Vatican II.

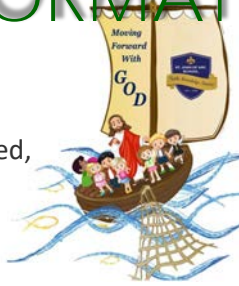

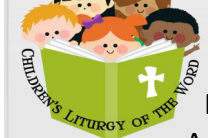
