H - O - N - O - R

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

In the Catholic Rite of Marriage, the couple is asked this important question: "Will you love and honor each other for as long as you both shall live?" Everybody gets the "love" part. But what about the "honor" part?

To *honor*. During the preparation for their marriage, I tell the engaged couple that "honor" is the Church's word for "respect." Respect is incredibly important, as we all know. Maybe as I am talking about respect, you are hearing in your mind Aretha Franklin spelling it out in song, R-E-S-P-E-C-T!

But "to honor" another seems to raise the stakes, doesn't it? The dictionary says honor means "*high* respect" or "to regard with *great* respect." Yes, to honor another is to go beyond giving "a little respect."

The Catholic Church calls the first Sunday in October "Respect Life Sunday." In fact, the entire month is known as "Respect Life Month." Maybe we should call it "**Honor Life Sunday and Month.**" Maybe that would help us take more notice of it.

We believe the Gospel of Jesus Christ calls us to honor the life of every person, from the life in a mother's womb to the life lying on a death bed. To honor you is to say you are important, significant, not an accident, not an inconvenience, not a problem. To honor you is to say your life matters, your life is sacred, holy. To honor someone is to see that person differently, to truly to see that we are one.

If we follow Jesus, we cannot pick and choose whose life we will honor.

Let's all practice it today and this week: honoring those seated at our dinner table, honoring those we call family, friends, coworkers, neighbor, honoring the opposing team on the soccer field (and the referee!), as well as honoring the person we disagree with, honoring the person who can really get under our skin.

Volleyball and Soccer teams are off to a great start. We value our volunteer coaches and appreciate their time and energy.

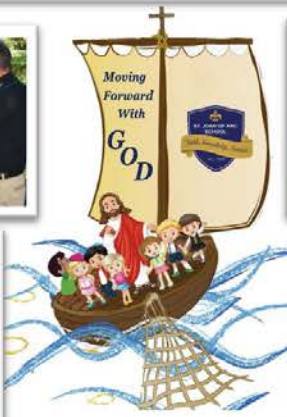
