If you have heard today's Gospel about 10 lepers healed and only one returning to give thanks to Jesus, it is most probable that you heard it at Mass on a Thanksgiving Day because this is the Gospel we usually read. I'm finding it interesting that this year this same Gospel shows up around another Federal holiday: Columbus Day.

As we all know, Columbus Day comes now with some controversy. Without getting into what this holiday should be named, we can all agree it is about people meeting people, people from afar meeting people already here. Close encounters of the human kind.

Unfortunately, when different cultures meet it is often with a crash. This was the case even in Jesus' day. I find it intriguing that in this gospel we find a word that is not used at any other point in the New Testament. The word? Foreigner.

This we can be sure of: in God's eyes there are none. No foreigners. Might be a good lesson for us in Church and in the country, too, this weekend and every day.

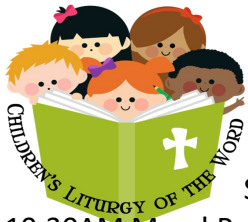

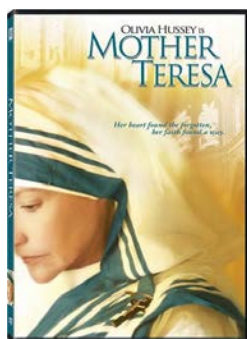
