GOSPEL

Luke 21:5-19

While some people were speaking about how the temple was adorned with costly stones and votive offerings, Jesus said, "All that you see here -- the days will come when there will not be left a stone upon another stone that will not be thrown down."

Then they asked him, "Teacher, when will this happen? And what sign will there be when all these things are about to happen?" He answered, "See that you not be deceived, for many will come in my name, saying, 'I am he,' and 'The time has come.' Do not follow them! When you hear of wars and insurrections, do not be terrified; for such things must happen first, but it will not immediately be the end."

Then he said to them, "Nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom. There will be powerful earthquakes, famines, and plagues from place to place; and awesome sights and mighty signs will come from the sky.

"Before all this happens, however, they will seize and persecute you, they will hand you over to the synagogues and to prisons, and they will have you led before kings and governors because of my name. It will lead to your giving testimony. Remember, you are not to prepare your defense beforehand, for I myself shall give you a wisdom in speaking that all your adversaries will be powerless to resist or refute. You will even be handed over by parents, brothers, relatives, and friends, and they will put some of you to death. You will be hated by all because of my name, but not a hair on your head will be destroyed. By your perseverance you will secure your lives."

"Value the Faith"

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

We have many funerals here at St. Joan of Arc, as evidenced by the long list of names in our Sanctuary, names of those buried from here since last November. I hear many eulogies (or Words of Remembrance, as we call them). I know some parishes don't allow them, but we do. And they are beautiful. They are heartfelt and quite poignant, many times humorous, and often very insightful. The deceased dads and moms, grandparents, aunts and uncles, sons and daughters, brothers and sisters and friends whom these eulogies honor are spoken of lovingly, respectfully, with great admiration. Knowing no one is perfect, it always encourages and inspires me, and I'm sure the family members present as well, to hear about the profound and life-changing impact the deceased's life has made on others, their love for others, and the values and faith they have passed on. Well, on that last point — the faith passed on — I don't hear a lot about that in eulogies. Don't get me wrong, in many I do. But many other times — even when the deceased has been a practicing Catholic and very active in parish-life, even when prayer and Mass has played a huge role in their lives — the faith life of the deceased is not mentioned.

There are perhaps many reasons for this. Perhaps the loved one's faith-life was very private and not so well known to his or her family. Perhaps the eulogist assumes the priest will talk about "that part" of the person's life in the homily (and hopefully the homilist will!). Perhaps the eulogist is not a church goer and therefore isn't familiar with Church language and expressions. I can understand the omission in all these circumstances.

Here is what concerns me. What if **the connection between one's values and one's faith in Jesus Christ** isn't immediately obvious to others, especially to our children, grandchildren and great-grandchildren? In other words, perhaps many in younger generations do not understand how the values they truly admire in their parents and grandparents spring from the latter's faith in Christ, how those values have been taught and nurtured by the Church they belong to, how it was the Eucharist and a life of prayer that gave them the strength and perseverance to be good persons, loving and forgiving persons, persons of joy, even in the midst of difficulties and struggles.

To those who are fifty years old and older (that includes me): if the role our faith has played in shaping our values is not immediately obvious to those younger than us, if it is not obvious to those younger how our faith has helped us get through tough times and challenges, how our faith helps us make moral decisions, if none of that is obvious, what can we do to make it so?

Launched in June 2022 on the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body & Blood of Christ, or Corpus Christi, the Bishops of the U.S. called for a **National Eucharistic Revival** in all dioceses over the next three years. Each week in our bulletin, we will offer a brief article as well as quotes from saints relating to the National Eucharistic Revival. Join us on an exciting journey ahead!

What is the National Eucharistic Revival?

It's a **response**....a joyful, expectant, grassroots response of the U.S. Catholic Church to Pope Francis' invitation for "a renewed personal encounter with Jesus"—particularly the transformational power and mercy of Jesus in the Eucharist.

It's a **movement**....to restore understanding and devotion to the great mystery of our faith—Jesus' Real Presence in the Eucharist, the source and summit of our faith.

Why do it?

To **inspire** a movement of Catholics across the United States who are healed, converted, formed and unified by an encounter with Jesus in the Eucharist—and who are then sent out on mission to be Jesus to all.

Why now?

Our Church is hurting. Scandal, division, disease, doubt. The Church has withstood each of these storms throughout our very human history. But today we confront all of them, all at once.

Our response is crucial since Jesus IS present in the roaring waves of the storms and is more powerful than any storm. Since many of us are separated from Jesus in the Eucharist, the very source of our strength and healing, the Eucharistic Revival reminds us that Jesus will heal, renew and unify the Church and the world. St Paul tells us we are united with Jesus in Eucharist: "Because there is one loaf of bread, we, though we are many, are one body, as we all share of the one loaf" (1 Corinthians 10:17)
