GOSPEL

Mt 24:37-44

Jesus said to his disciples:

"As it was in the days of Noah, so it will be at the coming of the Son of Man. In those days before the flood, they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, up to the day that Noah entered the ark.

They did not know until the flood came and carried them all away. So will it be also at the coming of the Son of Man.

Two men will be out in the field; one will be taken, and one will be left. Two women will be grinding at the mill; one will be taken, and one will be left. Therefore, stay awake!

For you do not know on which day your Lord will come.

Be sure of this: if the master of the house had known the hour of night when the thief was coming, he would have stayed awake and not let his house be broken into. So too, you also must be prepared, for at an hour you do not expect, the Son of Man will come."

YOUR SYNOD UPDATE

We have now entered the "**Continental Phase.**" Every country around the world has submitted a synthesis of literally thousands upon thousands of listening sessions which reflected on both the joys and the obstacles on our journey together as Church. From all of this, a

Document for the Continental Stage (DCS) has been produced and distributed back to all the dioceses around the world. You can read the DCS at www.usccb.org/synod (it is not too long and worth a read).

Each diocese will now provide 3-5 delegates who will participate in virtual gatherings to reflect upon and dialogue about the findings in the DCS (one of the delegates from the Trenton Diocese is Mrs. Marijane Michalowicz, a member of our own parish!). From the feedback of the delegates, a **North American Synthesis** (representing the United States and Canada) will be written and submitted to the Vatican by March 31, 2023. This document will be used when the Bishops convene for the Synod on Synodality in October of 2023 and 2024. This is a very exciting time in the Church. Please continue to pray for this Synodal process!

"WAIT FOR IT. CAN YOU?"

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

Sometime in the past twenty or thirty years or so, we ceased calling the folks who take our orders at restaurants waiters and waitresses. They are servers now. I like the name "server." It's a very Christian title, if you think about it. As disciples of Christ, we talk a lot about serving one another, serving the least among us, serving and not being served.

But I also liked the "waiter" thing. In fact, I think we could also say that disciples of Christ are supposed to be "waiters." Advent is, in fact, a season of waiting and joyful anticipation.

Advent wants to teach us how to wait.

Waiting isn't something we are very proficient at these days, not as individuals, and certainly not as a society. We get fully decorated for Christmas weeks before it. A member of our Liturgy Team recently said she wanted to buy a pilgrim to decorate her Thanksgiving table. Not one pilgrim could be found; everything was already elves and reindeer! Getting my haircut, I found myself humming along to "have a holly jolly Christmas" a week before Thanksgiving.

We have more on learning to wait deeper in this bulletin. But may I say here: for those who have already put up their Christmas tree (I know because of schedules and so forth sometimes you have to get it up super early), perhaps hold off on turning the lights on, just for a little while. Maybe the third Sunday of Advent, Joyful Sunday, would be a good day to flip the switch.

Speaking of Sundays and waiting, this year, because Christmas is on a Sunday, we get the longest possible of Advents. Four full weeks of Advent! This year, don't skip through Advent. Get that Advent Wreath out and put it on the kitchen table. Take it one day a time. Slow down. It's a great way to prepare a heart waiting for the coming of Christ!

WAIT...

For Your Prayer

Breathe slowly.

Slow down.

Don't rush through your praying or Scripture reading.

Take : 'wait' with you into your prayer.

What kind of "waiter" are you?

What or whom is hardest to wait on or wait for?

Pray to be at peace while waiting, even while praying.

Pray this week before Lighting the first candle on the Advent Wreath:

***O Saving Lord,
may this Advent teach us
to wait. To wait for
Christmas, and for Your
second coming,
prayerfully, patiently
and peacefully.
Amen.***



Jesus will return. "Christ will come again," we believe. We wait for His return. Why is it taking so long? Is God waiting for the right time? Does God wait for us?

What might God be waiting for?

We pray to the Lord for those:

waiting in long lines with us ...

waiting in soup kitchen lines ...

waiting for an end to war ...

waiting for test results ...

awaiting the birth of a child ...

young people waiting for their driver's license ...

kids waiting for Christmas morning ...

The little boy wailed, "I don't like to wait," and the adults around him had to stifle their urge to laugh. This four-year-old was expressing an impatience we know all too well. No one likes to wait, but it's a part of life that we learn to accept as we mature. When we're stuck in a long line at airport security or the DMV we develop strategies for coping. Mine is making sure I have something to read.

Advent calls us to recognize that waiting has intrinsic value as a spiritual discipline, asking that we ***slow down, take stock, and settle our hearts on the hope that rests in expectation.*** As Paul Tillich states in "*The Shaking of the Foundations*," all time, in both history and personal life, is expectation. Time itself is waiting, waiting not for another time, but for that which is eternal. During Advent the Church in its wisdom provides us with the opportunity to focus on our long wait for eternity. As we approach Christ's birth in Bethlehem, we are also awaiting his return. (Kathleen Norris, as found in "*Give Us This Day*")

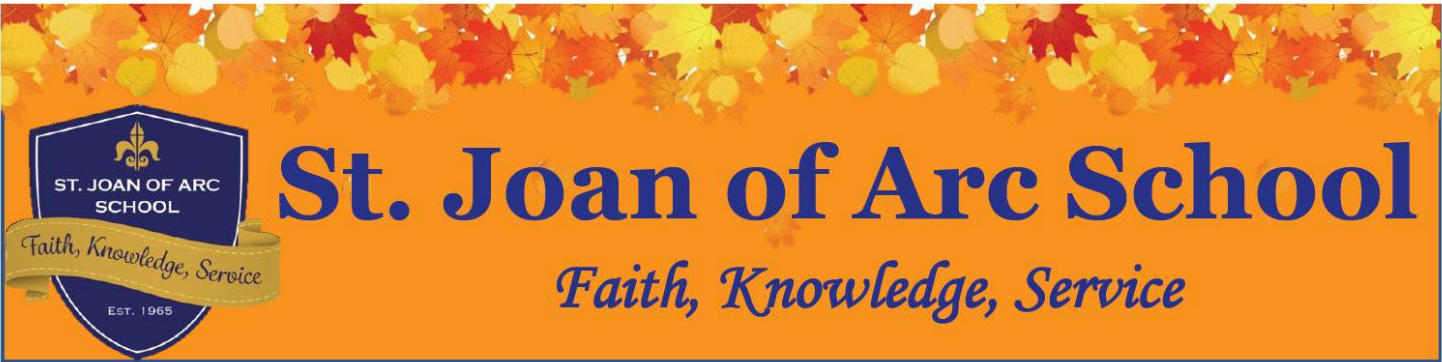

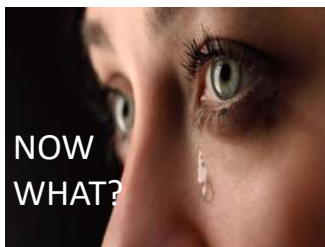
