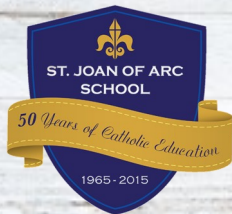

## GOSPEL

Luke 20: 27-38

Some Sadducees, those who deny that there is a resurrection, came forward and put this question to Jesus, saying, "Teacher, Moses wrote for us, *If someone's brother dies leaving a wife but no child, his brother must take the wife and raise up descendants for his brother.* Now there were seven brothers; the first married a woman but died childless. Then the second and the third married her, and likewise all the seven died childless. Finally the woman also died. Now at the resurrection whose wife will that woman be? For all seven had been married to her." Jesus said to them, "The children of this age marry and remarry; but those who are deemed worthy to attain to the coming age and to the resurrection of the dead neither marry nor are given in marriage. They can no longer die, for they are like angels; and they are the children of God because they are the ones who will rise. That the dead will rise even Moses made known in the passage about the bush, when he called out 'Lord, ' the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob; and he is not God of the dead, but of the living, for to him all are alive."

## "Our Sister Death"

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

Halloween was just this past Monday. For weeks prior to it we've driven by houses and yards in our neighborhoods decorated with skeletons, fake tombstones, goblins and ghouls and grim reapers and other assorted signs of death. It's all done in fun, of course, but they are nonetheless reminders that death, as the poets say, will come for us all, sometimes slowly, sometimes like a thief in the night, as Jesus tells us.

Nature tells us the same thing this time of year. Leaves turning and shriveling and falling. Green grass going brown; skies more gray than blue. When you think about it, Halloween just wouldn't work in April or May as nature springs back to yellow and pink and red or in July when nature's greens and blues are their deepest shades. To put Halloween in the summer would be a really bad mixed message.

Even so, with all the signs and symbols of death, our society seems to do all that it can to deny its reality. We are reluctant to admit to growing old. We plan funerals around our kids' soccer schedules.

We do not deny it in here, in Church, especially during this time of year. We, as a people of faith, acknowledge death, our mortality. At the end of every Hail Mary, a prayer we teach to five year olds, we ask the Blessed Mother to pray for us now "and at the hour of our death." We ask St. Joseph to give us a "peaceful death." "Sister Death," St. Francis of Assisi called it. We hang a crucifix in our homes, over our beds.

Jesus Christ lived *and* died to show us how to do both, how to live, how to die. Neither is for ourselves. As St. Paul writes: "For it we live, we live for the Lord, or if we die, we die for the Lord; therefore, whether we live or die, we are the Lord's" (Romans 14:8).

# YOUR SYNOD UPDATE



## ***SYNOD: To Journey Together***

### **The National Synthesis — Part Two**

This past summer, regional boards summarized reports from every diocese across the United States (the Diocese of Trenton is part of Region 3, New Jersey and Pennsylvania). From these summary reports, the U.S. Bishops Conference wrote and just recently released the **National Synthesis** which can be read on [www.usccb.org](http://www.usccb.org). Last week we included a summary of the Enduring Wounds in our journey together. The Synthesis also included other specific topics which also repeatedly arose that “can be understood as a common longing underlying the experience of the Church in the United States. These topics are invitations to discernment, reflection, and dialogue as we continue to walk the synodal path.” Below we have included some of these topics.

**SACRAMENTAL LIFE:** “The Eucharist in the lives of Catholics was a significant starting point for many of the synodal consultations. While divisions exist, many saw the Eucharist as the source of hope for greater unity as the Body of Christ.”

**A WELCOMING CHURCH:** “The most common desire named in the synodal consultations was to be a more welcoming Church where all members of the People of God can find accompaniment on the journey.” People noted the Church sometimes “prioritizes doctrine over people; rules and regulations over lived reality. People want the Church to be a home for the wounded and broken, not an institution for the perfect.”

**ONGOING FORMATION FOR MISSION:** “Another common hope that emerged from the synodal consultations was the desire for life-long spiritual, pastoral, and catechetical formation as disciples. Synodal consultations made clear the importance of evangelization as we continue to live out the Church’s mission, which requires stronger formation.” Also noted was the need for clear communication, “especially in the digital space, for reaching out to and engaging young people. Nearly all synodal consultations cautioned, however, that the Church and Catholic media engage in social and digital communications in ways that are both responsible and respectful, avoiding falling into ideologies that exacerbate division.”

**CO-RESPONSIBILITY:** “A genuine appreciation for the role of the laity in the Church and its mission was a hope that arose in many of the synodal consultations.” The synthesis noted “the tension between a genuine love for clergy expressed frequently in the synodal experience, balanced by an awareness of clericalism preventing full accompaniment and collaboration by the laity.”

**ENGAGED DISCERNMENT:** “There was wide acknowledgment from the regions that the call to participate in a synodal time in the Church was initially met with skepticism and suspicion; however, the regions also report that the experience itself dispelled many of the misgivings that participants brought with them to the process.” The Synthesis also noted that “at this moment in the synodal journey, one may agree or disagree with some of the perceptions heard and expressed, but we cannot assume they have no importance in lived reality.”

**WHAT IS NEXT?** On October 27, The Vatican issued the [Document for the Continental Stage \(DCS\)](#) The DCS is a working document that will be used for the next step, the Continental Stage, of the Synod process and is a result of the Holy See hearing from 112 episcopal conferences, including the National Synthesis provided by our own United States Bishops.

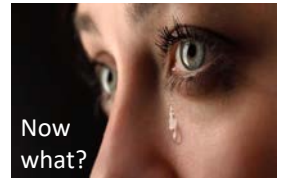
