3rd SUNDAY OF ADVENT/2022

"GO AND TELL SOMEONE"

Go and tell John what you see and hear!! I remember singing that lyric in high school chorus. I sang baritone. Just that one line, that's what I remember from that song. Go and tell John what you see and hear!

The rest of the lyric, of course, can be found in today's Gospel. John the Baptist, who just last week was filled with such conviction about the coming of the Messiah — he will baptize with fire, John said — now seems a bit more confused about whether Jesus really is the one they have been waiting for. John sends his disciples to Jesus with this question: "Are you the one?" Jesus sends them back with this answer (and I can hear Jesus singing it:)

Go and tell John what you see and hear! The blind see! The lame are walking! Lepers are healed and sent home dancing! Those who couldn't hear, now can! And the poor, yes, the poor, they now finally have something to cheer about — they have Good News!

Jesus says, show John the evidence and let him be the judge of whether or not the Kingdom of God is upon him.

This is week three of the longest Advent we can have, a full four weeks! We light the candle that isn't purple. We light it for joy!

Does Jesus fill you with joy? Does the Good News of a God who can't stay away from us, a God who won't stop loving us, a God who will keep us company when we are happy and when we are sad, does that Good News make you happy?

Then go and tell ... someone!

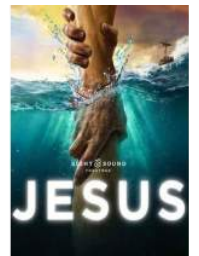
