GOSPEL

Mt 3:1-12

John the Baptist appeared, preaching in the desert of Judea and saying, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand!" It was of him that the prophet Isaiah had spoken when he said: *A voice of one crying out in the desert, Prepare the way of the Lord, make straight his paths.* John wore clothing made of camel's hair and had a leather belt around his waist. His food was locusts and wild honey. At that time Jerusalem, all Judea, and the whole region around the Jordan were going out to him and were being baptized by him in the Jordan River as they acknowledged their sins.

When he saw many of the Pharisees and Sadducees coming to his baptism, he said to them, "You brood of vipers! Who warned you to flee from the coming wrath? Produce good fruit as evidence of your repentance. And do not presume to say to yourselves, 'We have Abraham as our father.' For I tell you, God can raise up children to Abraham from these stones. Even now the ax lies at the root of the trees. Therefore every tree that does not bear good fruit will be cut down and thrown into the fire. I am baptizing you with water, for repentance, but the one who is coming after me is mightier than I. I am not worthy to carry his sandals. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire. His winnowing fan is in his hand. He will clear his threshing floor and gather his wheat into his barn, but the chaff he will burn with unquenchable fire." 2nd SUNDAY OF ADVENT/2022

"A WHISPERING JOHN THE BAPTIST?"

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

We assume John the Baptist was shouting out there in the desert of Judea. His message was, "Repent!" "Repent" sounds like a word that should be shouted, or at least spoken with great intensity!!

The translation of the Gospel we use tells us how John "appeared, preaching in the desert of Judea and saying, 'Repent, for the Kingdom of heaven is at hand!'" Now, in a desert, with all that wide open space, you'd guess you'd need more volume, and preaching implies, if not shouting, certainly a more impassioned style of speech.

Remember: John is announcing the coming of the Kingdom of Heaven. How could one announce such an event without a great deal of exuberance!

Finally, the gospel writer, Matthew, tells us outright that it was of John that the prophet Isaiah wrote, "A voice of one crying out in the desert." John was crying out. Shouting. Using high energy and enthusiasm.

All good for desert preaching.

Here's my own hunch: in today's crowded, fast-paced, high volume, noisy, message-bombarded world, one more loud voice might not be heard.

And this message needs to be heard. It must be heard.

That's why I think maybe John would whisper it. With just as much joy and conviction.

So, ssh. This week listen for that whispering voice deep inside you. You are loved. You are not alone. The Kingdom of God ... which is everything that is God, all of God's love and mercy and peace ... is at hand, within reach, within you!

Eucharistic Revival

A number of polls over the past decade have shown that a large number of Catholics do not understand what the church teaches about the Eucharist. In 2019, the Pew Research Center found that the majority of Catholics don't believe in the real presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. This nationwide crisis of belief in the Eucharist was part of the impetus for the National Eucharistic Revival.

So for the next three years, 56 American priests will travel the country striving to "light a fire" among Catholics nationwide about Eucharistic faith and devotion. The priests are part of a National Eucharistic Preachers initiative that is now underway.

Sister Alicia Torres, a co-coordinator of the initiative, states, "We envision these priests going out into the dioceses that invite them to bring the message in a fresh way that our Lord is truly present in the Eucharist and that our relationship with him changes lives."

The 56 priests come from a diverse group of dioceses and religious orders that stretch across the U.S. They were identified for the role by their own bishop or religious superior "as dynamic preachers who had a particular love for the Eucharist," Torres said.

Dioceses can request a National Eucharistic Preacher to come during their own diocesan year. Suggested events include gatherings for diocesan and parish leaders, special Masses and Eucharistic holy hours, youth and young adult events, clergy conventions and retreats, and Eucharistic assemblies.
