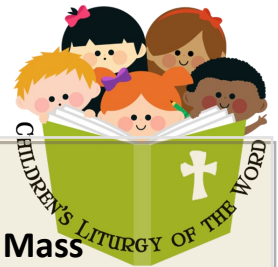
RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

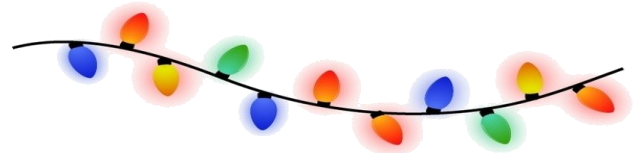

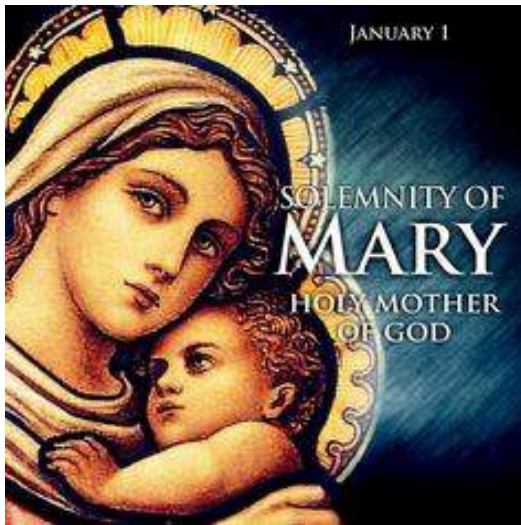
