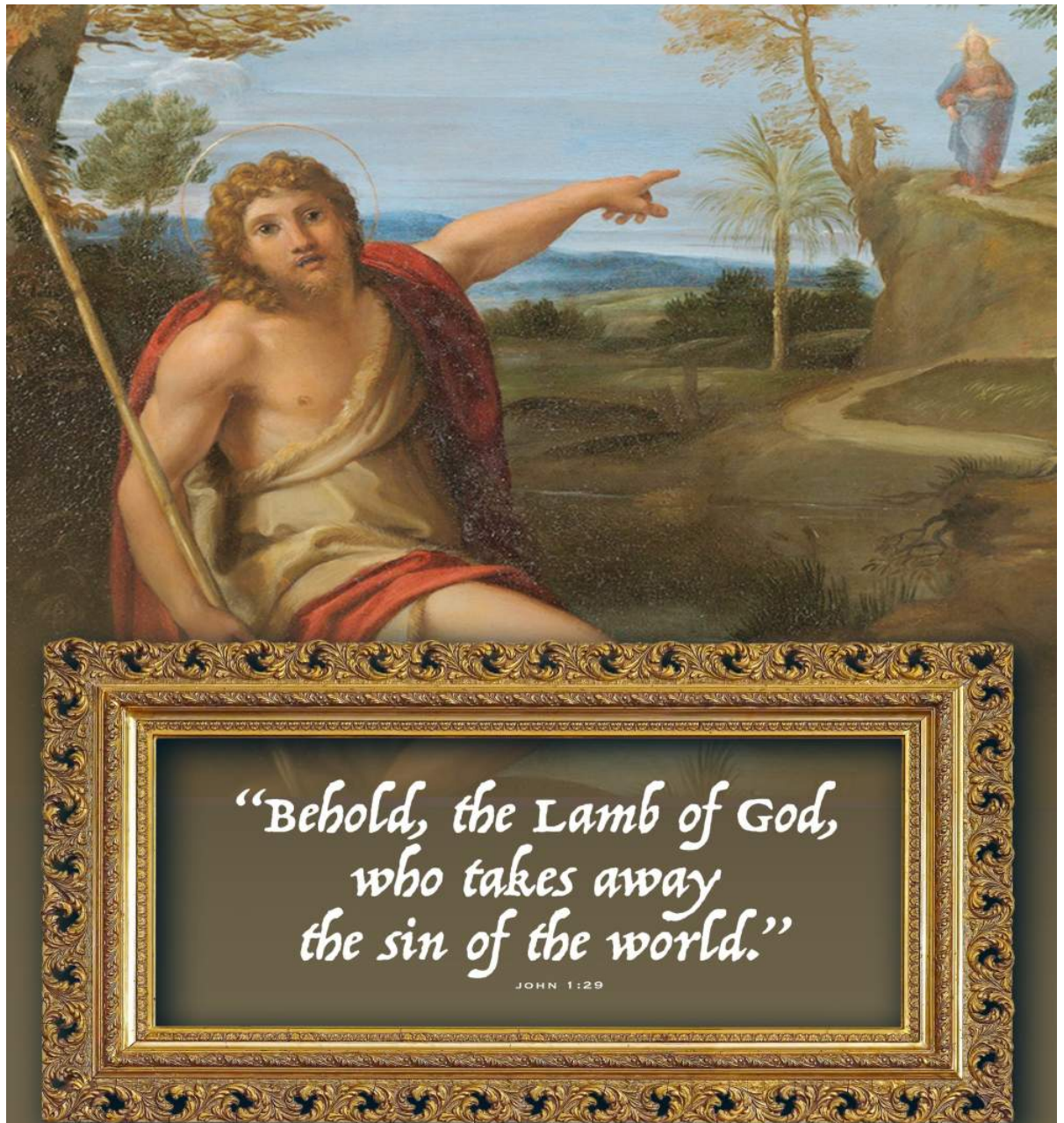

## 2<sup>nd</sup> SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME / 2023

### "Behold, Cycle A!"

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

Oh, boy. Having now officially put the Christmas Season behind (though we can't part from the poinsettias just yet ... they look too healthy!), we enter Ordinary Time. We are now in Cycle A of our Lectionary. The Lectionary is the book of select Scriptures that we read each Sunday. The Scriptures are divided into a three year cycle so that in three years — if you come every Sunday — you will have heard a good portion of the entire Bible. All of this is great, of course. What I am thinking about, however, is that the last time we were in Cycle A was 2020.

Oh, boy. Three years ago as we were entering Ordinary Time we had no idea that the year upon us was going to be one of the most unusual years of our lives. There was nothing ordinary about 2020.

While I certainly do not wish us to ever repeat anything like what we went through during that year, I do think it has something important to teach us:

***We never know what is coming around the corner.***

Oh, we plan. We have our schedules. We have our "to-do" lists. We set out each day knowing all that needs to be done. We have our daily chores and responsibilities. We look forward to our celebrations and times shared with family and friends. But even with all of that, never know what will come.

Oh, you are now thinking, how depressing. But that's not where I am going at all.

Behold, you never know when out of the blue your day takes a turn that brings unexpected joy, unanticipated love, unpredicted peace. This is exactly why we come to church each Sunday. This is why we listen to the Scriptures. This is why we are fed with Christ Himself, the Bread of Life, in the Eucharist. So that we can train our hearts to be ready to be surprised by the astonishing presence of Christ.

The "Behold!" we hear on the lips of John the Baptist in today's Gospel (John 1:29-34), reminds us to live as "Behold!" people. To say, "Behold, the sunrise!" "Behold, a child's smile!" Behold, how grace-filled every moment can be ... even the seemingly worst of moments. Behold, Christ can be found even there.

Behold, Cycle A Scriptures! May we hear them with new ears! May they surprise and challenge us this year! May our faith grow in unexpected ways!

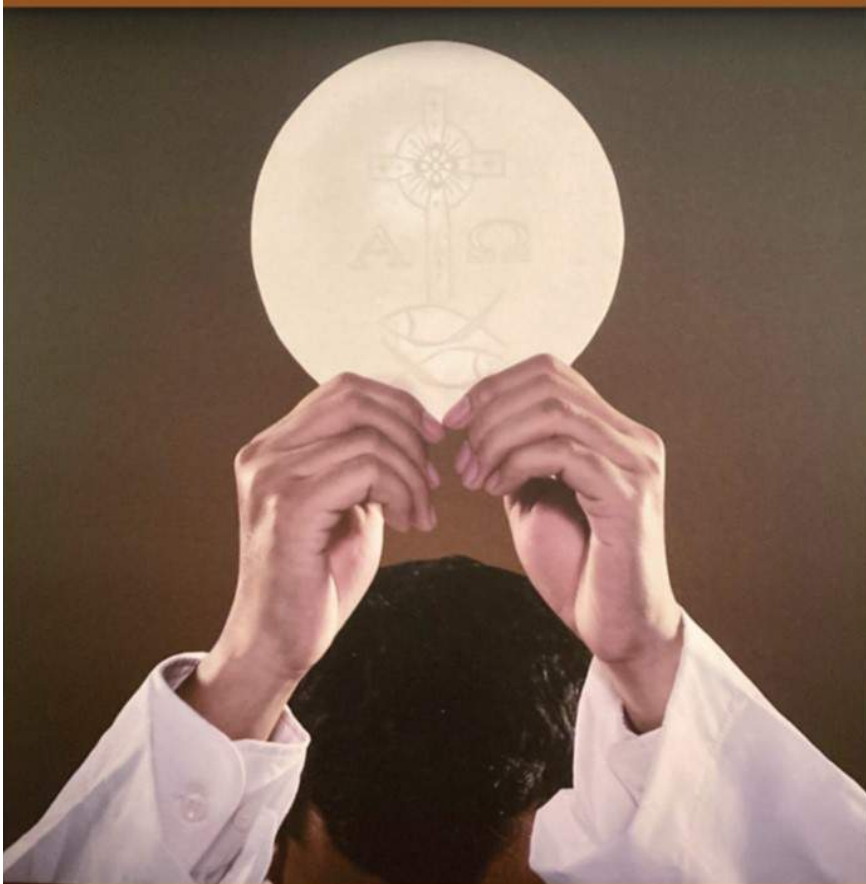

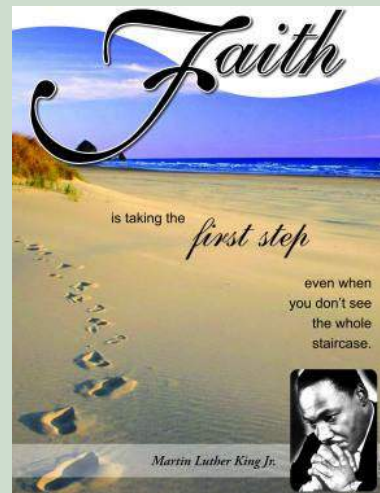
