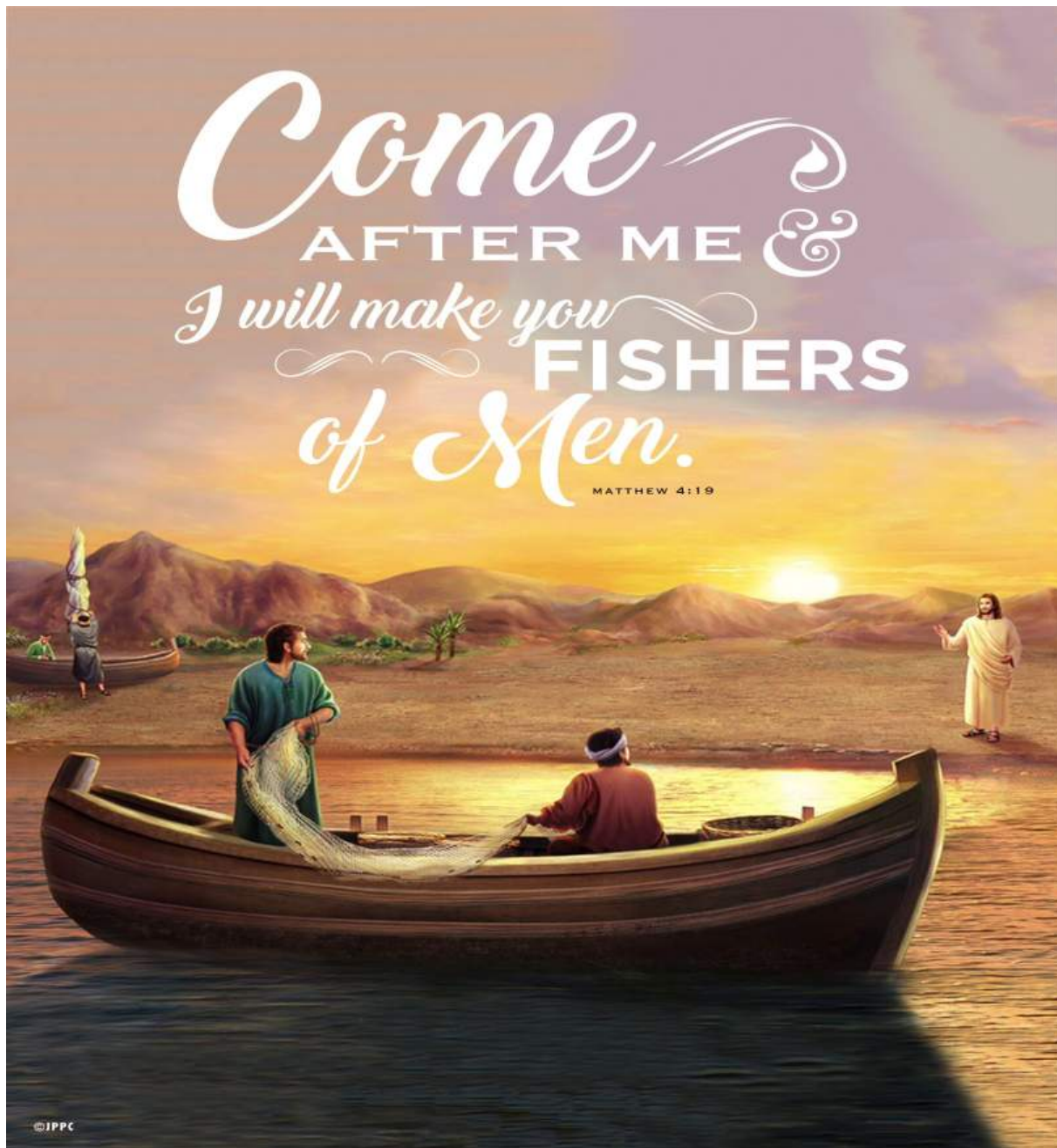

## GOSPEL

Matthew 4:12-23

When Jesus heard that John had been arrested, he withdrew to Galilee. He left Nazareth and went to live in Capernaum by the sea, in the region of Zebulun and Naphtali, that what had been said through Isaiah the prophet might be fulfilled:

*Land of Zebulun and land of Naphtali,  
the way to the sea, beyond the Jordan,  
Galilee of the Gentiles,  
the people who sit in darkness have seen a great light,  
on those dwelling in a land overshadowed by death  
light has arisen.*

From that time on, Jesus began to preach and say, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand."

As he was walking by the Sea of Galilee, he saw two brothers, Simon who is called Peter, and his brother Andrew, casting a net into the sea; they were fishermen. He said to them, "Come after me, and I will make you fishers of men." At once they left their nets and followed him. He walked along from there and saw two other brothers, James, the son of Zebedee, and his brother John. They were in a boat, with their father Zebedee, mending their nets. He called them, and immediately they left their boat and their father and followed him.

He went around all of Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, proclaiming the gospel of the kingdom, and curing every disease and illness among the people.

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

I am going to make a bet. In our own individual private prayers, I'll bet you have not included a petition for Christian Unity more than five times in your lifetime. Would I win the bet?

It is just not something we regularly pray for. Me included, sad to say. Except during the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity which runs from January 18-25.

And yet, so many in our families and church have married someone of another Christian denomination (maybe that's you!)

And yet, we all know and are friends with persons of other Christian denominations.

And yet, Jesus himself made it his prayer the night before he died. He prayed, "Let them all be one." He was talking about the generations to come after his first disciples. He was talking about us.

Instead of being one, truthfully, we've kind of made a mess of it.

I believe we can find in our diversity great unity. I believe our diversity in Christianity, much like in our country, can be a great strength and a greater source of hope for the whole world.

Unity can begin in our prayers but must be lived out in our attitudes, in our words and in our actions.

One suggestion: as you drive by any church, not just a Catholic one, pray for the community of faith that meets there. Pray that the members of that community will grow more in love of God and one another. Pray that our unity with them might produce good fruits of peace and harmony that spills over to the greater community, to the entire country and world.

Let us pray for one another. Let us be one. It would be an answer to Jesus' prayer.

**Summer Religious Education** - Last year, we were happy to offer our summer intensive program again, and we will also be able to offer it again this year.

June 26<sup>th</sup> - July 7<sup>th</sup> from 8:30 am - 12:30 pm daily  
(except no class on July 4<sup>th</sup>)

The intensive nature of this program allows our children to learn about their faith through daily classes which cover our Diocesan curriculum, daily Mass attendance and teaching Masses with Msgr. Rich and Fr. JM, "field trips" to our prayer garden, music practices with Mr. Peiffer to help us learn the songs we will sing at Mass, and more. We had a truly wonderful, faith-filled experience offering this program to our children last year, and we are looking forward to doing the same this year.

As we begin to prepare for our summer program, we invite you to consider joining us! We are looking for catechists (teachers) and classroom aides. We will provide classes to help prepare you to share your faith with our children. **About our Summer Program** - The Summer Program is an intensive option, and as such, requires that children entering grades 1st through 8th must have completed the prior year's curriculum in our program so that they are prepared when the two weeks of classes begin. Due to the scheduling of the classes, this program is a very popular option. For practical reasons (space, volunteers, etc...), we are limited in the number of students we can register for the summer. Our hope is to be able to grow our Summer Program so that we can expand the number of spots we are able to offer.

Attendance each day during the Summer Program is a requirement, as we cover so much material daily. Families must also attend a certain number of liturgies or events at St. Joan's during the year to ensure that children are continuing to grow in faith within the parish community.

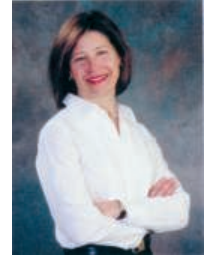
