## "The Sermon That Changed Everything"

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

We have heard it so much it may have lost its edge. That happens, doesn't it? But when Jesus preached the Sermon on the Mount, when he opened this most famous of sermons with the Beatitudes, it was brand new and it was eye-popping and heart-stopping. This sermon presented a whole new vision of God and of God's Kingdom. It gave a whole new way of relating to God and to each other.

Today's Gospel gives us those Beatitudes, the opening verses of Jesus' sermon on the Mount. Try to listen to them with new ears. Take the words with you this week. Perhaps each day this week read one verse, one Beatitude, and pray over it, write it down or put it on your calendar or in your notes on your phone. See where the Beatitude takes you. Ask, "What is Jesus trying to tell me about who God is and what God thinks is important?" In what ways does the verse comfort you? Or challenge you?

In Matthew's Gospel, Jesus is the New Moses, the New Lawgiver. It is a different kind of law, one that demands not only obedience but a change of mind and heart. Your mind and heart. My mind and heart. The minds and hearts of all who want to follow Jesus.

# ADULT FAITH FORMATION

## EUCCHARISTIC REVIVAL

...Everything we do in preaching the Gospel has one goal: to bring people to the Eucharist. Why? Because this is where we encounter Christ himself, where he gives us his life, and where he teaches us how to fulfill the meaning of our lives. He is the source and the summit.

The Eucharist is not only a place to encounter Jesus and receive his life, the source, but also the place where we give him ourselves in worship, the summit. It is where we offer ourselves, our labors, and all created things, together with Christ, which fulfills the reason we were created.

*"None of us will be happy unless we learn to make a gift of ourselves. Isn't this what Jesus taught when he said, 'This is my Body given up for you'?"*

The Eucharist wants to teach us to make our own lives a gift. We need to catechize people about this aspect of the Eucharist in order that they might fully live their Christian lives....

*"The Eucharist wants to change us into lovers in a twofold movement: Jesus comes to us to encounter us in his love, then this love transforms us."*

The Eucharist is more than just an encounter with love. It is that; it is the most profound encounter with love possible in this life. But the Eucharist is more than just receiving a gift. We are meant to be transformed by this gift....

Dear Parishioners,

Peace! Seems like yesterday that we were saying "Merry Christmas" and "Happy New Year". January is quickly coming to an end.

We began 2023 with our annual retreat day. It was wonderful to go back to pre-Covid times. We entered church as a school community of faith processing down the center aisle. There is something very powerful watching hundreds of SJA children walking into church beginning the new year with the celebration of the Eucharist. As we travel through these next 324 days, we join all those who are partaking in different Eucharist Revival activities. Our hope is to deepen an awareness of and appreciation for the gift of Jesus in Eucharist. We wrote poetry, made mass schedules and explored the parts of the liturgy from beginning to end.

Another activity was the making of the hopes and dreams for 2023, via a mobile or a booklet.

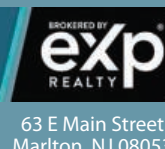
