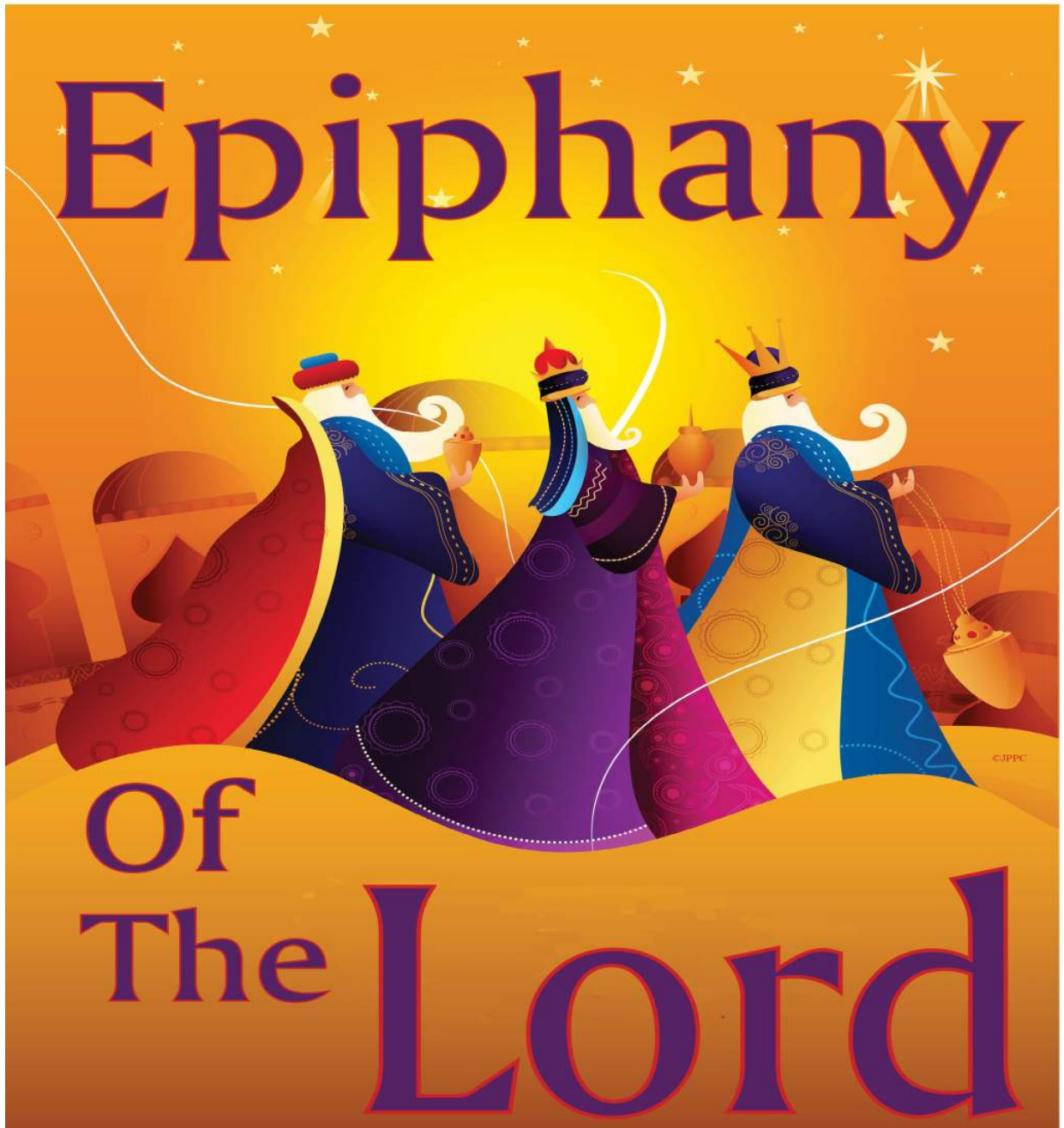

GOSPEL

Mt 2:1-12

When Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judea, in the days of King Herod, behold, magi from the east arrived in Jerusalem, saying, "Where is the newborn king of the Jews? We saw his star at its rising and have come to do him homage." When King Herod heard this, he was greatly troubled, and all Jerusalem with him. Assembling all the chief priests and the scribes of the people, He inquired of them where the Christ was to be born. They said to him, "In Bethlehem of Judea, for thus it has been written through the prophet:

*And you, Bethlehem, land of Judah,
are by no means least among the rulers of Judah;
since from you shall come a ruler,
who is to shepherd my people Israel."*

Then Herod called the magi secretly and ascertained from them the time of the star's appearance. He sent them to Bethlehem and said, "Go and search diligently for the child. When you have found him, bring me word, that I too may go and do him homage." After their audience with the king they set out. And behold, the star that they had seen at its rising preceded them, until it came and stopped over the place where the child was. They were overjoyed at seeing the star, and on entering the house they saw the child with Mary his mother. They prostrated themselves and did him homage. Then they opened their treasures and offered him gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh. And having been warned in a dream not to return to Herod, they departed for their country by another way.

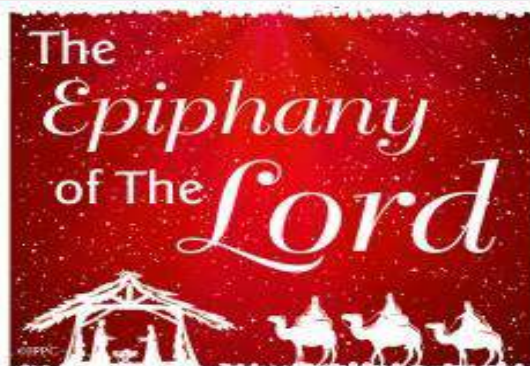

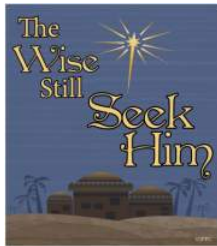

ADULT FAITH FORMATION

EUCCHARISTIC REVIVAL **POPE BENEDICT XVI** **ON THE EUCHARIST**



This past Thursday our Church said farewell to Emeritus Pope Benedict XVI during his Mass of Christian Burial. A prolific writer before and during his papacy, Pope Benedict authored many books and articles on the Eucharist. The following excerpts are taken from his *The Spirit of the Liturgy*.

“It has always been clear that the goal of the Eucharist is our own transformation, so that we become ‘one body and spirit’ with Christ” (1 Corinthians 6:17).

“The Eucharist is meant to transform us, to change humanity itself into the living temple of God, into the Body of Christ ...”

“True, the Eucharistic Body of the Lord is meant to bring us together, so that we become his ‘true body.’ But the gift of the Eucharist can do this only because in it the Lord gives us *his* true Body.”



“The living Lord gives himself to me, enters into me, and invites me to surrender myself to him, so that the Apostle’s words come true: “It is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me” (Galatians 2:20).

How wonderful it would be if each of us, by the end of 2023, could say with St. Paul: “It is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me.” This is the goal of the Eucharist.

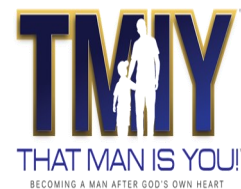
Next Meeting
