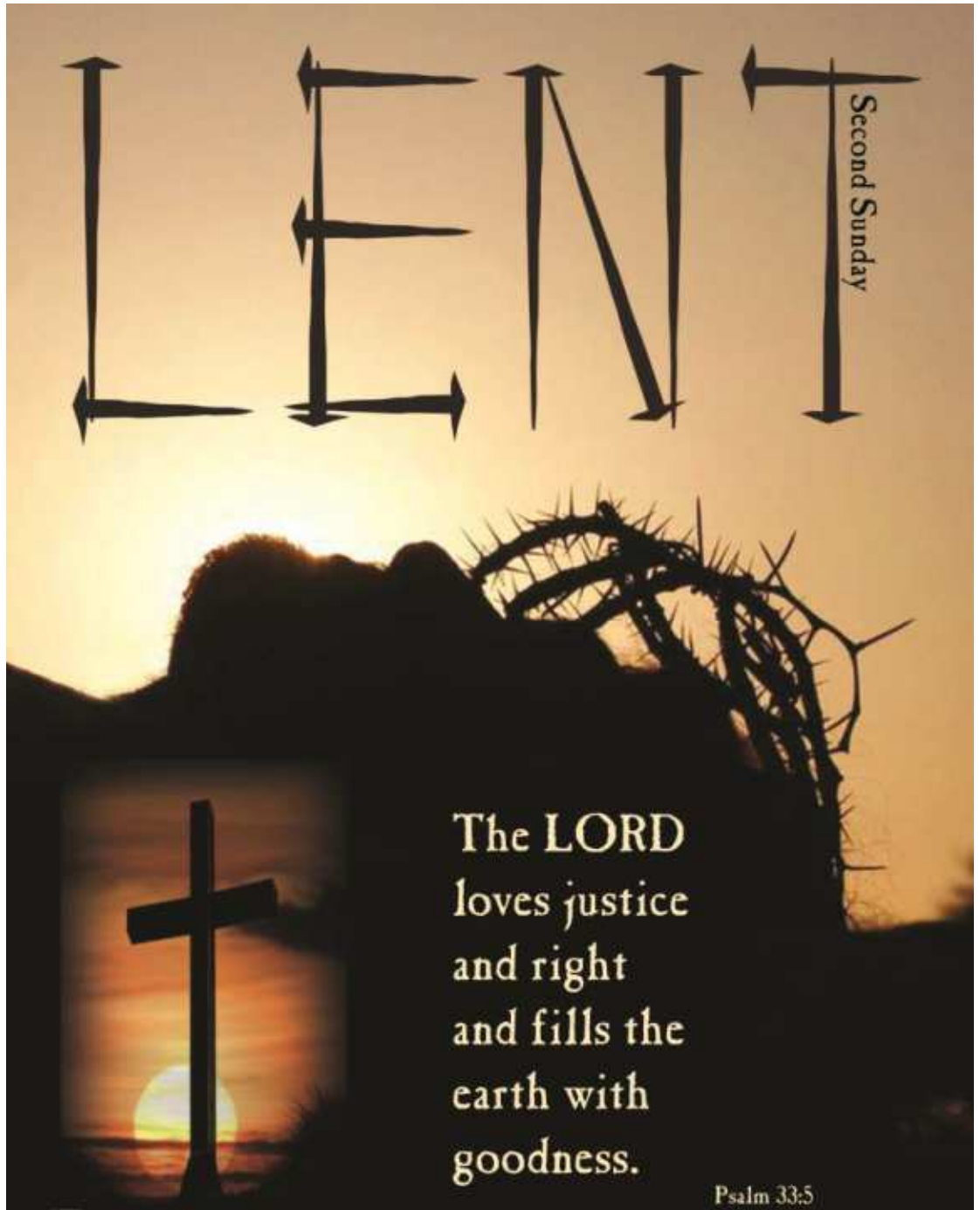

Matthew 17:1-9

Jesus took Peter, James, and John his brother, and led them up a high mountain by themselves. And he was transfigured before them; his face shone like the sun and his clothes became white as light. And behold, Moses and Elijah appeared to them, conversing with him. Then Peter said to Jesus in reply, "Lord, it is good that we are here. And when the disciples raised their eyes, they saw no one else but Jesus alone. As they were coming down from the mountain, Jesus charged them, "Do not tell the vision to anyone until the Son of Man has been raised from the dead."

## "So Revealing"

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

Transparency is a popular word and concept these days. According to Oxford Dictionary, in 1923, the word was hardly ever spoken or heard. In the last twenty years or so, its use has taken a gigantic jump.

We like transparency especially in finances, in politics and in leadership. We are distrustful when things are veiled, hidden, purposely covered up and obscured.

God likes transparency, too.

What? We might think of God as the most veiled and hidden reality there is! What could be more difficult to read and understand than God's own Word in the Bible. God and mystery go together, right! Well, yes and no.

Something might be difficult to understand, but that doesn't mean it cannot be known or experienced.

And God wants to be known and experienced!

That is the whole point of the Scriptures. That is why we have them. But, even more: that is why that Word became flesh, for us, so that we would know and experience God and God's love. This is what Jesus does.

It was only 8 Sundays ago that we celebrated Epiphany, the Feast of God's Manifestation, God revealing Himself as the Savior of the world in the infant Christ. From the manger to a mountaintop we now see Jesus transfigured. Where once in the stable he was flanked by His mother Mary and Joseph, we now see Him flanked by Moses and Elijah. Jesus Christ is the fulfillment of the law and prophets. On Good Friday, this same Jesus will be hanging on a cross flanked by two common thieves. And God will be revealed.

This Lent, get to know God.

Jesus will show you.

# Re-Lent Week 2 “REVEAL”

Reveal ... from *revelare*, a Latin word meaning “uncover, disclose.”

Go back three years ago to when the pandemic and the lockdown interrupted our lives, our Lent and this cycle of Sunday Scriptures: what did that time reveal or uncover about yourself? How did you handle the disruption of “ordinary life” and your regular routine? Is there anything you would have done differently?

In today’s Gospel account of the Transfiguration, Jesus is revealed in glory as God’s beloved Son, as the fulfillment of the law and the prophets. In your daily life, where do you “meet” and “see” Christ? How is He revealed to you?

Do you feel you have a relationship with Jesus? Did you have one as a child? How has it changed over the years?

What role does the Eucharist play in revealing Christ to you?

## SJA PRAYER GARDEN

The printing company engraving our prayer garden pavers has increased the cost of engraving. There has not been an increase in cost since the creation of the prayer garden in 2012. Due to the cost increase the 6x9 pavers will now sell for \$120 each and \$5 extra for an added cross. 9x9 pavers are no longer available.

Paver ordering submittals will be **ONCE A YEAR** starting in March 2023 instead of two times a year.

### **THE NEXT PRAYER GARDEN PAVER ORDER DEADLINE IS MARCH 31, 2023 FOR SPRING/SUMMER INSTALLATION**

- 6"x 9" paver with ALL CAPITAL LETTERING, 3 lines of 16 characters per line, including spacing and punctuation is \$120. Only 6 x 9 pavers are remaining. Paver orders will now be ordered only once a year in March.
- Cross on paver can be purchased for an additional \$5. It will only be placed on the top of the paver and centered. This location of the cross does not count as a character line.

Pavers can be purchased for those who have died, in remembrance, the living or some other special event in life. **Certificates for the pavers are now available.**

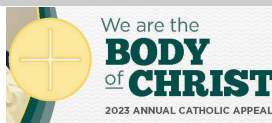
